I am directed to refer to the subject noted above and to say that Lokayukta, Haryana has drawn the attention of the State Government towards the provisions of the Haryana Lokayukta Act-2002, Section 17(2) which is read as under:-

“the Competent Authority shall cause the report to be examined and communicate to the Lokayukta within 3 months of the date of receipt of the report, the action taken thereon.”

2. It has been observed by the Lokayukta, Haryana that even after the recommendations of Lokayukta, the Action Taken Reports are not submitted in consonance with the aforesaid provision of the Act. The Action Taken Reports are being sent by the various officers to the office of Lokayukta directly in a casual manner. To curb the tendency of sending the action taken reports in a casual manner, the Government has decided that it shall be ensured in the future that the action taken reports should be communicated to Lokayukta through competent authority within the stipulated time period, duly in compliance with the provisions of the Act. Further, Section 2 (d) of the Haryana Lokayukta Act, 2002 has defined the competent authority as under:-

“Competent Authority” in relation to a complaint against:-
