Whereas, the petitioner namely Smt. Tejinder Pal Kaur [5003156], PGT Punjabi [Guest] approached the Hon'ble High Court by way of filing CWP No. 27350 of 2022 titled as Rachna Saxena and others versus State of Haryana & others praying therein to issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents not to adjust the guest teachers at the place of petitioners by way of transfer as the guest teachers cannot be replaced/dislocation by way of transfer of other guest teachers AND to issue a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representations dated 20.11.2020 (Annexure P-10).

Further, this case has been disposed of by Hon'ble High Court on 30.11.2022. The operative part of the order is as follows:-

"Notice of motion.

Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representations of the petitioner(s), if already filed or submitted by the petitioner(s) within a period of three days from today, will be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submit that once the respondents have undertaken to decide the grievance raised in the representations, in order to avoid the harassment, the petitioner(s) be allowed to continue at their present place of posting till the decision of the said representations so that in case, tomorrow their grievance is accepted, they are not uprooted again so as to cause further inconvenience to the teachers.

Keeping in view the above, it is directed that till the decision of representations already filed by the petitioner(s) or filed till Friday, petitioner(s) will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting. It is made clear that in case, petitioner(s) have already been relieved, they will be allowed to join back at the same place of posting till the decision.
