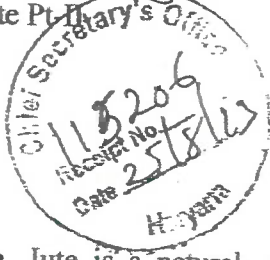

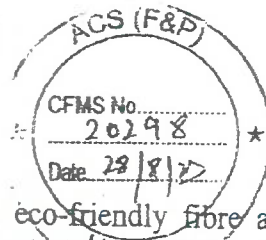

Dear Sir,

As you are aware, Jute is a natural, renewable and eco-friendly fibre abundantly produced in India. A range of Jute Diversified Products are made from jute fibre and widely used almost all over the world.

2. Among these, Jute Geotextiles, a fabric either woven, non-woven, has emerged as a natural, sustainable and effective solution in many areas like (i) erosion control of soil, (ii) stabilization of earthen or hill slopes, (iii) construction of roads including haul roads, (iv) erosion control of river bank, and (v) control of railway track subsidence including embankment, apart from its use in Agri-horticulture and forestry etc.

3. These products have been standardized by Bureau of Indian Standards and also included in the Schedule of Rates by some State Governments such as West Bengal, Assam & Meghalaya. Research Designs & Standard Organization of Indian Railways has also included these in their Unified Standard Schedule of Rates and Indian Roads Congress has already published guidelines for road construction with the use of Jute Geotextiles.

National Jute Board (NJB), a statutory body under the Ministry of Textiles, is involved in promotion of Jute Diversified Products including Jute Geotextiles in India and abroad. Model analysis of Rate for the purpose of different applications and technical specifications of Jute Geotextiles are provided by the National Jute Board. Also, specific handholding and workshops are organized by NJB.

5. I would like to request you to kindly consider giving necessary directions to various Departments under the State Government including Public Works Department, Irrigation and Waterways Department and all other Engineering Departments and organizations to include Jute Geotextiles as an item of work in their Schedule of Rates and promote their usage.
