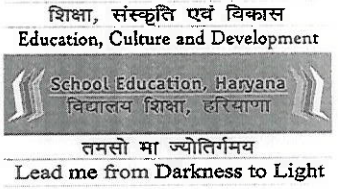

Whereas, the petitioner had filed the CWP No. 10842 of 2023 titled as Mali Chand Vs State of Haryana and others, before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, praying therein for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner from the date his juniors have been regularized and to grant all the consequential benefits.

The aforesaid writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court on 18.05.2023 and on that day Hon'ble Court was pleased to dispose of with the direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation of the petitioner. The operative part of the said order is as under:-

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2- Director General, School Education, to decide legal notice dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner, within a period of ten weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of this order, by passing a speaking order, as per law.

In compliance of the above said direction of the Hon'ble High Court, the legal notice dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner was examined by the department and it has been found that the petitioner was engaged as Part time Class IV employees against unsanctioned post of sweeper at Government Middle School Gothra, Bhiwani (Now Charkhi Dadri) on 02.08.2001 only for a short span of 3^{1/2} hours and after that, the petitioner was free to do any work or job anywhere else.



Whereas, as per the earlier departmental policy dated 30.12.1998/25.02.1999, the seniority of part time Class-IV employees was at institutional level. Only those part time Class-IV employees were entitled for regularization under the said policy, who had requisite experience mentioned in the policy in the institutions where they were working as part time class IV against vacant sanctioned post of Class- IV. But since the petitioner does not fulfil the terms and conditions of the said policy and hence could not be regularized under the regularization policy dated 30.12.1998/25.02.1999.

Whereas, after superseding the earlier departmental regularization policy dated 30.12.1998/25.02.1999, a new departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003 came into force and as per the departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003, a common seniority list of all the part time Class-IV employees working in Govt./Primary/Middle/High/Sr. Secondary Schools and the field offices like O/o BEOs/SDOs/DPEOs/DEOs/SCERT/DIETs/GETTIs etc. as on 30.06.2003 was prepared by the DEOs concerned at District Level and accordingly the petitioner stands at seniority no.130. This seniority list of part time Class-IV employees acts as a reference point for sponsoring the names of the senior most employee for regularization of their services against vacant regular sanctioned post but subject to conditions mentioned in para nos.12 and 14 of the said policy dated 11.11.2003 and para nos.12 &14 of the said policy is reproduced as under:-

Para 12:-First of all those Class-IV posts part - time employees shall be regularized only against the regular sanctioned Posts available/ becoming available in Govt. School/ offices strictly on the basis of their seniority in the common seniority list who have completed at last six years of continuous service on their post and whose work and conduct is satisfactory. While calculating 6 years of continuous service the break in such service due to vacation shall also be counted in the length of service. The remaining employees would be considered for regularization thereafter on the basis of their seniority

provided duly sanctioned Class-IV posts are available. The very fact that a part-time Class-IV employee has completed more than six years of continuous service shall not confer a right on such employee for regularization of his/her services if no sanctioned posts are available or if such employee is lower in seniority. Every such employee will be considered for regularization only on his/her turn provided a duly sanctioned Class-IV post is available”.

Para No.14:-Whereas as per the Departmental Regularization Policy dated 11.11.2003/27.02.2004, those Class IV part time employees who have already completed at least six years of continuous service may be given relaxation in the prescribed academic qualifications for the post of Chowkidar, Waterman/Water Carrier (Kahar), Sweeper, Beldar and Mali at the time of regularization as the prescribed qualification for all these employees is their ability to read and write Hindi. However, no relaxation in academic qualifications shall be given to such part -time employees for regularization against the post of Peon as the prescribed qualifications for the post of peon is middle pass with knowledge of Hindi. Relaxation in age may be given to those part time employees who were within the prescribed age limit at the time of initial recruitment.”

Whereas, in the context of the case of the petitioner, it has been found that the petitioner is literate only, so he is eligible for regularization only to the post of Mali/Sweeper but subject to availability of vacant sanctioned post.


Whereas, Sh. Sombir Singh was engaged as a part time class IV employee in Government Girls Sr. Sec. School, Charkhi-Dadri of the District Bhiwani (now Charkhi Dadri) against un-sanctioned post on 01.10.2001 and his services were regularized in view the regularization policy of 11.11.2003/27.02.2004 w.e.f 13.01.2021 vide order no. E-IV-24/1761-66 dated 01.04.2024 in view of the departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003 as per his eligibility and availability of vacant sanctioned post of peon, so Sh. Sombir Singh had been regularized to the post of peon being

middle pass, but the petitioner does not possess the essential qualification for the post of peon and hence could not be regularized till date.

Keeping in view of the position explained above, the claim of the petitioner demanded through Legal Notice Dated 18.01.2023 (Annexure P-4) is not tenable at this stage. He would be considered for regularization as per his turn and on the availability of vacant sanctioned post of Sweeper/Mali as the regularization to the post of Sweeper/Mali has been done up to seniority no.125 in District Charkhi Dadri but the petitioner is at seniority no.130. Hence, at the juncture, the claim of the petitioner is hereby rejected being devoid of merits.

I order accordingly.

Whereas, the petitioners had filed the CWP No. 7212 of 2019 titled as Sumatra & Others Vs State of Haryana and Others before the Hon'ble High Court, praying therein for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus commanding the respondents to consider the case of the present petitioners and decide the legal notice dated 19.12.2018 (P-5) by passing a speaking order within a stipulated period and further prayed that their case is squarely covered under the order dated 04.09.2014 passed in CWP No.14131 of 2016 (P-6) titled as Mukesh Kumar & Others vs. State of Haryana & Others.

The aforesaid writ petition came up for hearing on 22.05.2023 and on that day, the Hon'ble High Court was pleased to dispose of the same with the direction to respondent No.2 to decide representation of the petitioners. The operative part of order is under:-

“Without commenting anything on the merits of case, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh representation for redressal of their grievance before respondent No.2, within 15 days from today, if so advised. If such a representation is filed within the aforesaid stipulated period, the same shall be decided within a period of six month thereafter, by passing a speaking order, as per law.

In compliance of the above said direction of the Hon'ble High Court, the representation dated 09.03.2024 of the petitioners was examined and it has been found the petitioner Nos. 1 to 5 were engaged as part time class IV in GPS, Kuslipur on 15.01.2001, in GPS Dungerepur on 16.07.2002, in GPS Suzwari on 17.07.2000, in GPS Akbarpur Natoli on 30.12.1995 and in GPS Jaindapur on 06.08.1998 respectively of Palwal District who were regularized on 23.10.2017 as sweeper cum Chowkidar in GMS Kuslipur, on 23.01.2018

as sweeper cum Chowkidar in GMS Dhaulagarh, on 23.10.2017 as sweeper in GMS Chirwari, on 28.08.2014 as sweeper cum Chowkidar in GSSS Jaindapur and on 05.08.2014 as waterman in GSSS Jaindapur respectively.

Whereas as per the departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003, a common seniority list of all the part time Class-IV employees working in Govt./Primary/Middle/High/Sr. Secondary Schools and the field offices like O/o BEOs/SDOs/DPEOs/DEOs/SCERT/DIETs/GETTIs etc. as on 30.06.2003 was prepared by the DEOs concerned at District Level and accordingly the petitioners stand at seniority nos. 102,112,92,8 and 44 respectively, this seniority list of part time Class-IV employees acts as a reference point for sponsoring the names of the senior employee for regularization of their services against vacant regular sanctioned post. Therefore, all the petitioners were regularized as per their eligibility, seniority list as well as on the availability of vacant sanctioned posts in Palwal District as per the departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003.

Whereas, para No.12 of the departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003, clearly provides that "first of all, those class IV part time employees shall be regularized only against the regular sanctioned posts available/becoming available in Govt. Schools/offices strictly on the basis of their seniority list who have completed at least six years of continuous service on their post & whose work & conduct is satisfactory. While calculating 6 years of continuous service the break in such service due to vacations shall also be counted in the length of service. The remaining employees would be considered for regularization thereafter on the basis of their seniority provided duly sanctioned class IV posts are available. The very fact that a part time Class IV employee has completed more than six years of continuous service shall not confer a right on such employee for regularization of his/her services if no sanctioned posts are available or if such employee is lower in seniority. Every such employee is lower in seniority every such employee will be

considered for regularization only on his/her turn provided a duly sanctioned class IV post is available.”

Hence as per the departmental regularization policy dated 11.11.2003 the seniority of part time class IV employees is of district level & the same cannot be overlooked on the basis of the example of the counterparts of the petitioners of other district as is the case of Nafe Singh and Nehru Singh who belongs to other districts and as far as the employees of CWP No.18296 of 2014 titled as Sanjay & Others vs. State of Haryana & Others and CWP No. 14131 of 2015 titled as Mukesh Kumar & Others Vs. State of Haryana & Others are concerned they belongs to other district namely Panipat & Hisar. Thus, the petitioners cannot take benefit of regularization at par with their counterparts of other districts.

Keeping in view of the position explained above, the claim of the petitioner demanded through representation dated 09.03.2024 is not tenable & hence rejected being devoid of merits.

I order accordingly.
