


OFFICE ORDER

Subject: Submission of pleadings in civil matters for vetting in the Office of Advocate General, Haryana

With effect from 27.01.2025, all the pleadings to be filed in the Hon'ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana in civil matters such as Civil Writ Petitions, Regular Second Appeals, Letters Patent Appeals, Civil Revisions, Misc Applications, Regular First Appeals, written statements/replies etc., including the fresh filings wherein the State is petitioner or appellant shall physically only and no online vetting shall be entertained. The person deputed for the vetting purposes shall be well acquainted with the facts of the case and shall bring along the record of the case relevant for the purposes of vetting.

In all such pending civil matters wherein replies, written statements, status reports, affidavits, applications etc., are to be filed on behalf of the concerned department, it shall be mandatory to submit the file for vetting in the office of Advocate General, Haryana 4 days prior to the date of hearing. No request for vetting shall be entertained if less than 4 days are left for date of hearing from the date of submission of the file for vetting, except in exceptional cases and only if the vetting is submitted along with the written request from the Head of the Department concerned.

This order shall be communicated to all the departments, boards, corporations etc. forthwith for information and making necessary arrangements accordingly.



Subject: To Discontinue the e-vetting of replies/Filing in cases i.e CWP, LPA, RSA, RFA, FAO, RA, CR and Misc. Applications with effect from 27.01.2025 and to Resume the Physical Vetting for clearer and better communication and the timely and effective mechanism.

Earlier owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, the vetting of replies as well as of draft of filing of CWP, LPA, RSA, RFA, FAO, RA, Civil Revisions and Misc. Applications required to be filed by the Departments was ordered to be done online/e-vetting. Now, in light of the improved situation concerning the COVID-19 pandemic, and in accordance with the latest health and safety guidelines, the practice of online vetting will be discontinued in above said cases. The Law Officers are facing difficulties in vetting of the same, due to lack of proper instructions. So, it has been decided that with effect from 27.01.2025, NO online vetting of Reply/Filing of CWP, LPA, RSA, RFA, FAO, RA, Civil Revision and Misc. Applications shall be accepted by office of the Advocate General, Haryana.

The departments are hereby informed to get the vetting of the aforesaid cases from the office of Advocate General, Haryana, Physically. Officials are hereby directed to attend in person for vetting purposes. This will enable smoother and more efficient processing of necessary documentation and official requirements. Please make arrangements to come to the office for the vetting process at the earliest.

The concerned official coming for vetting should be well versed with the facts of the case and should also come with the relevant record pertaining to the case concerned. This will allow for clearer and better communication and the timely and effective mechanism.

We appreciate your cooperation in resuming this procedure physically. Thank you for your understanding and prompt attention to this matter.
