Order No.13/113-2025 PGT-II (6)

Whereas, the petitioners have filed Civil Writ Petition No. 22470 of 2025 titled as **"Amarnath and others Vs State of Haryana and Others"** before the Hon'ble High Court, praying for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned Rule10 of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 dated 30.12.2008 (Annexure P-1) and rule10 of Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016 dated 28.10.2016 (Annexure-P 5) to the extent of denying increment to the retirees who retired prior to 1<sup>st</sup> of July of any year completing six and more than 6 months of service before retirement being absolutely unjustified illegal and arbitrary having no nexus with the ultimate object to be achieved. Further prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the increment to the petitioners on completion of six and more than six months of service before retirement by granting the same and to fix the pension on the last pay drawn with all consequential retiral benefits including re fixation of pension and other retiral benefits alongwith all arrears with interest @18% from the due date.

The present matter came up for hearing on 24.04.2025 before the Hon'ble Court the operative part of order is as under:-

***"For order, see detailed judgment of even date passed in CWP No.14627 of 2024 titled as "MAHABIR SINGH TANWAR V/S STATE OF HARYANA AND OTHERS."***

The present matter is disposed of in terms of order dated 24.04.2025 passed in CWP no.14627 of 2024 titled as *"Mahabir Singh Tanwar v/s State of Haryana and others."* The operative part of the order is reproduced as under:-

***"11.The State authorities shall also take into consideration any policy decision which the State government may take with respect to the persons, who retired having put in more than six***



*months and less than one year of service in their last year of tenure.*

**12. Pending application(s), if any, in all the writ petitions are disposed of accordingly."**

In compliance of the aforesaid orders of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, it has been found that the petitioners no. 4, 9, 18, 21, 22, 23 and 25 has been retired from the post of PGT Lecturer on attaining the age of superannuation. The details of the petitioners are as under:

Whereas, the Finance Department has circulated detailed guidelines vide Memo No. 6/44/2024-4PR (FD)/1697 dated 16/17.09.2025 and 02.06.2026 pertaining to the matters regarding the grant of annual increments to the retired employees.

As per above circular, the judgment dated 11.04.2023 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India passed in Civil Appeal No. 2471 of 2023 titled as '*The Director (Admn. And HR) KPTCL & Others Vs. C.P. Mundinamani and others*', the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court disposed of number of cases on the same lines with directions to the respondents to grant one increment. However, these cases also included such petitioners who had completed six months or more but less than one year service. One of such writ petition i.e. CWP No. 14857 of 2023 titled as Jagdish Rai Gupta Vs. State of Haryana & ors. was allowed by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 15.04.2024.

Whereas, keeping in view legal opinion No. 2423 dated 13.06.2024 of the Ld. Advocate General, Haryana in CWP No. 14857 of 2023- Jagdish Rai Gupta Vs. State of Haryana & ors. and in other similar cases, various SLPs have been filed before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, vide interim order dated 11.02.2025 has stayed the operation of impugned orders dated 21.05.2024 passed in CWP No. 11985 of 2024 - Sant Lal Aggarwal Vs. State of Haryana & ors.

Whereas, the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court has disposed of a bunch of CWPs in leading CWP No. 14627 of 2024- Mahabir Singh Tanwar Vs. State of Haryana & ors., vide orders dated 24.04.2025 in the terms of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court on 20.02.2025 in Miscellaneous Application Diary No. 2400 of 2024 in Civil Appeal 3933 of 2023 with connected miscellaneous applications titled as Union of India and another Vs M. Siddaraj. The Hon'ble High Court has further directed the Administration-respondents to pass a specific orders taking into consideration the facts of each case and the



State authorities shall also take into consideration any policy decision which the State Government may take with respect to the persons, who retired having put in more than six months and less than one year of service in their last year of tenure.

Pursuant to the aforementioned order dated 20.02.2025 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Misc. Application Diary No. 2400/2024 in Civil Appeal No. 3933 of 2023- Union of India & anr. Vs. M Siddaraj, the Ld. Advocate General, Haryana, vide legal opinion dated 03.04.2025, has opined as under:-

*As regards the other category of retired employees i.e. those who retired before 30th June i.e after completing 6 months or more service but less than one year, their entitlement for grant of an increment was neither under consideration nor has been decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the aforementioned cases."*

Whereas, keeping in view the judgment dated 24.04.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court passed in CWP No. 14627 of 2024- Mahabir Singh Tanwar Vs. State of Haryana & ors., matter was further considered regarding those employees who retired on or before 30th June/31st December (as the case may be) after completing 6 months or more service but less than one year, it is observed that they would not be entitled to the benefit of one notional increment in terms of orders dated 20.02.2025 passed in Misc. Application Diary No. 2400/2024 in Civil Appeal No. 3933 of 2023- Union of India & anr. Vs. M. Siddaraj, as their entitlement for grant of one notional increment was neither under consideration nor has been decided by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the issue is still to be considered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court. Thus, this issue is pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the SLPs already filed by the State Government and in many cases operation of the impugned order has already been stayed.

Therefore, the benefit of proportionate increment to such retired Government Employees/Petitioners is not tenable at this stage reason being that the Rule also provides that if a person has rendered more than six months service, he would not be deemed to have completed 12 months of service for the purpose of grant of increment.



Accordingly, in the light of above mentioned rules and factual position, the demand raised by the petitioners no. 4, 9, 18, 21, 22, 23 and 25 is found to be devoid of any merits and, therefore, rejected at this stage.

**Order No.13/31-2026 PGT-II (6)**

**Dated, Panchkula, the 16-7-2026**

Whereas, the petitioners have filed Civil Writ Petition No. 33362 of 2024 titled as **"Nirmala and others Vs State of Haryana and Others"** before the Hon'ble High Court, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari or Mandamus to challenge Rule 10 of "The Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules 2008" (ANNEXURE/P-1). The petition challenges the provision that denies annual increments to employees retiring on or before June 30 each year, despite completing the required six months of service to qualify for an increment under "The Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008". It argues that such employees should be entitled to annual increments for the retiring year, based on their service duration as stipulated. Further to direct the respondents to re-fix the petitioners' pension by granting them annual increments in their retiring year. The petitioners have completed the required six months or more of service as stipulated by the Revised Pay Rules, 2008, for the grant of annual increments. Relief is also sought for consequential benefits, including arrears, with interest.

The present matter came up for hearing on 24.04.2025 before the Hon'ble Court the operative part of order is as under:-

***"For order, see detailed judgment of even date passed in CWP No.14627 of 2024 titled as "MAHABIR SINGH TANWAR V/S STATE OF HARYANA AND OTHERS."***

The present matter is disposed of in terms of order dated 24.04.2025 passed in CWP no.14627 of 2024 titled as *"Mahabir Singh Tanwar v/s State of Haryana and others."* The operative part of the order is reproduced as under:-

***"11.The State authorities shall also take into consideration any policy decision which the State government may take with respect to the persons, who retired having put in more than six months and less than one year of service in their last year of tenure.***



**12. Pending application(s), if any, in all the writ petitions are disposed of accordingly.”**

In compliance of the aforesaid orders of the Hon'ble Punjab and Haryana High Court, it has been found that the petitioners no. 11 and 14 has been retired from the post of PGT Lecturer on attaining the age of superannuation. The details of the petitioners are as under:
