**Screening Process for Deployment of Teachers in GMS/PMS/CMEEE Schools**  
***(for deployment in Govt. Model Sanskriti, PM SHRI & CM EEE Schools)***

In continuation of the Deployment Policy, 2026 notified by the Department of School Education, Haryana, the following detailed instructions are hereby issued regarding the conduct of the Screening Process and the eligibility conditions for applicants seeking deployment in Government Model Sanskriti Schools (GMS), PM Shri Schools (PMS), and Chief Minister Excellence & Early English Schools (CMEEE):

**1. Applicability**

This Circular shall apply to all regular and guest teachers and Heads of Schools desirous of deployment in the above-mentioned Schools of Excellence, provided they are below the age of **55 years** on the cut-off date.

**2. Screening Process Components**

The Screening Process shall consist of two components with a total of **100 credit points**:

**a) Academic Performance**

- Maximum of 40 points for C&V (Languages), TGT, ESHM, HM, PGT, and Principal.
- Maximum of 30 points for PRTs, HTs, and C&V (Drawing/PTI, etc.).
- Credit points shall be calculated at **0.1 mark per 1% obtained** in each qualification.
- Distribution of points:
  - PRT: 10th (10), 12th (10), D.El.Ed (10)
  - C&V (Drawing/PTI, etc.): 10th (10), 12th (10), Diploma (10)
  - HM/ESHM/TGT/C&V (Languages): 10th (10), 12th (10), Graduation (10), B.Ed./O.T. (10)
  - PGT: 10th (10), Graduation (10), Post-Graduation (10), B.Ed. (10)
  - Principal: 10th (10), Graduation (10), Post-Graduation (10), B.Ed. (10)

*Note:* For teachers where B.Ed. was not compulsory, a weighted average of other qualifications shall be considered.

**b) Screening Test**

- Written test of 60 marks for TGT, ESHM, HM, PGT, C&V (Languages), and Principal.
- Written test of 70 marks for PRTs, C&V (Drawing/PTI), and HTs.

**c) Final Merit** The final merit shall be the sum of academic credit points and screening test marks.

**d) Language Papers** The question paper for each language subject shall be set in that respective language.

**e) Nature of Screening** The Screening Process is purely qualifying in nature; allocation of stations shall be made strictly on the basis of merit criteria defined in the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2026.

**3. Participation in Transfer Drive**

- Passing the Screening Test does not guarantee compulsory deployment; teachers shall remain in a pool for three (03) years if vacancies are fewer than qualified candidates.
- A teacher who has passed the Screening Test is not compulsorily required to participate in the transfer drive, as participation is voluntary.
- All teachers and Heads of Schools desirous of deployment must indicate a minimum of **three (03) stations or more** during the transfer drive.
- A teacher who does not get any station of choice may:
  - Stay back in the same station, if tenure is not completed.
  - Participate in the General Transfer Drive, if tenure at the present posting station has been completed.

#### 4. Eligibility of Previously Screened Candidates

- Teachers who successfully passed the Screening Test conducted by BSEH in June 2025 are eligible to apply not only for GMS and PMS schools but also for the newly established CMEEE schools.
- Teachers appearing in the forthcoming Screening Test shall be eligible to opt for any vacant station in GMS, PMS, or CMEEE schools.
- Teachers already posted in GMS/PMS schools through CENTA Test, Interview, or other approved scrutiny are also eligible to choose posting stations in CMEEE schools, in addition to GMS and PMS schools, without re-screening.

#### 5. Cadre Restrictions

- **District Cadre Teachers (Primary & C&V Drawing/PTI):**
  - No primary or C&V Drawing/PTI teacher belonging to district cadre shall be permitted to opt for a station outside their permanently allocated district.
  - However, primary teachers who were posted outside their allocated district through any previous drive meant for screened teachers shall be permitted to opt for a station available within their permanently allocated district.
- **Mewat Cadre Teachers:**
  - No teacher belonging to Mewat cadre shall be permitted to opt for a station in RoH (Rest of Haryana).
  - Teachers from RoH may opt for a vacant station in Mewat cadre.
  - Preference for vacancies in Mewat cadre shall always be given to teachers belonging to Mewat cadre.

#### 6. Validity of Screening Test

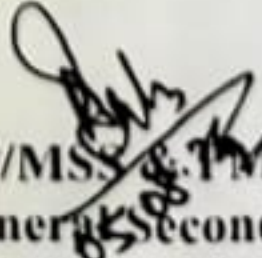
- The validity of passing the Screening Test shall be **three (03) years** from the date of qualification.
- Teachers who passed the Screening Test but could not be deployed in GMS/PMS/CMEEE schools within three years shall be required to reappear in the Screening Test.
- Teachers who have been promoted after passing the Screening Test shall also be required to undergo the Screening Test afresh for deployment in GMS/PMS/CMEEE schools.

#### 7. General Conditions

- It shall be mandatory for all Associate NCC Officers (ANOs) to pass the Screening Test to get posted or remain posted in GMS/PMS/CMEEE schools. Screened ANOs shall not be transferred unless surplus or voluntarily opting.
- Surplus teachers redeployed under rationalization shall continue to enjoy eligibility without re-screening.
- Teachers deployed in Aarohi Model Schools through CENTA are eligible to participate directly in the GMS/PMS/CMEEE deployment drive, provided they opt for transfer in the present drive. However, if they do not participate in the present deployment drive, they shall not be given any opportunity in future, and their status of having passed the screening shall stand annulled.
- All other provisions of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2026 shall remain applicable *mutatis mutandis*.
