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Notice

In compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court Orders dated 01.09.2025 passed in Civil Appeal No. 1385/2025 titled as Anjuman Ishaat-e-Taleem Trust vs. State of Maharashtra and others & orders dated 29.05.2026 passed in Review Appeal No. (C) Diary No. 53434/2025 in Civil Appeal No. 1385/2025 State of U.P. Vs. Anjuman Ishaat-e-Taleem Trust & others all the teachers of the state are hereby directed that:-

1. The teachers who are presently working and having more than 5 years of service left as on 01.09.2025 and have not passed HTET till date, they must have to qualify the HTET examination in their concerned subject/level they are teaching presently, otherwise; they shall have to quit services or they may be compulsorily retired from service.
2. The teachers who are having tenure of less than 5 years in service as on 01.09.2025 and not having HTET certificate, may continue their services till they attain the age of superannuation without qualifying the HTET. However, such teacher (having less than five years' service left) aspires for promotion, he/she will not be considered eligible for promotion without having qualified the HTET in the subject concern.
3. All the District Education Officers/District Elementary Education Officers of the state are hereby directed to bring this in the notice of all the teachers under their jurisdiction.
4. The orders dated 01.09.2025 and 29.05.2026 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in above stated case is available on the official website of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and same are also uploaded on Departmental website for the kind perusal and information of all the stake holders in the State.
5. Board of School Education, Bhiwani is hereby directed to conduct the HTET Examination twice a year, so that eligible teachers may be afforded reasonable opportunities for acquiring HTET Certificate.
6. Concerned establishment branches of Directorate of School Education (DSE/DDE) are also directed to promote/appoint teachers strictly in compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court orders dated 01.09.2025 and 29.05.2026.
