- 5. Trained Teachers and non-teaching staff.
- 6. Rs. 2200/- per month per student being paid to institution towards maintenance allowances in aided special workshops, for the category of Visual Impaired, Hearing Impaired and Locomotor Disability.

7. Rs. 2450/- per month per student being paid to institution towards maintenance allowances in aided special workshops, meant for Intellectual Disability.
