The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years. 2. Minimum Educational Qualification a. Candidate with Science who have passed the qualifying 12th Standard examination (10+2) and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together and passed in English individually. b. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only. c. English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc. (Nursing). 3. Colour blind candidates are eligible provided that colour corrective contact lens and spectacles are worn by such candidates. 4. Candidate shall be medically fit.5. Married candidates are eligible to apply. 6. Students shall be admitted once in a year Foreign Students Under University Quota The students should satisfy the following conditions: i. The candidate should have individually passed English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology as subjects and obtained a minimum aggregate of 50% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.</li> <li>OR</li> <li>ii. Shall have passed any other examination conducted by boards/Councils/Intermediate examination established by State Government/Central Government and recognized as equivalent to a two year Pre-University Examination of Karnataka State with English Physics, Chemistry and Biology as subjects. The candidate should have individually passed English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology as subjects and obtained a minimum aggregate of 50% in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.</li> <li>• In the case of a foreign national, an equivalence certificate needs to be obtained from the approved authority as per the University Statutes</li> <li>2. Age:</li> <li>i. A candidate seeking admission to Bachelor of Physiotherapy course should have completed 17 years of age, as on 31st December of the year of admission.</li> <li>ii. Every candidate before admission to the course shall furnish to the Dean of the Institution a certificate of Medical Fitness from an authorized Government Medical Officer to the effect, that the candidate is physically fit to undergo Physiotherapy course.</li> </ul>

LLB Hons in Cyber Security</b> 1.Passed in 2nd PUC / 12th Std / Equivalent Exam from a recognized board with a minimum aggregate of 45% mark or equivalent in any subject (Science, Arts, Commerce, etc.). <b>BA LLB Hons</b> 1.As per BCI Rule 5 (b): An applicant who has successfully completed Senior Secondary School course ('+2') or equivalent (such as 11+1, 'A' level in Senior Senior School Leaving certificate course) from a recognized University of India or outside or from a Senior Secondary Board or equivalent, constituted or recognized by the Union or by a State Government or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country recognized by the government of that country for the purpose of issue of qualifying certificate on successful completion of the course, may apply for and be admitted into the program to obtain the integrated degree in law with a degree in any other subject as the first degree from the University whose such a degree in law is recognized by the Bar Council of India for the purpose of enrolment. Provided that applicants who have obtained + 2 Higher Secondary Pass Certificate after prosecuting studies in distance or correspondence method shall also be considered as eligible for admission in the Integrated Five Years course.</p> <p>Explanation: The applicants who have obtained 10 + through open Universities system directly without having any basic qualification for prosecuting such studies are not eligible for admission in the law courses.</p> <p>As per BCI Rule 7: Minimum percentage of marks not below 45% of the total marks in case of general category applicants and 40% of the total marks in case of SC and ST applicants, to be obtained for the qualifying examination, such as +2 Examination in case of Integrated Five Years' course for the purpose of applying for and getting admitted into a Law Degree Program of the University in either of the Programmes. Provided that such a minimum qualifying marks shall not automatically entitle a person to get admission into the university but only shall entitle the person concerned to fulfill other criteria notified by the University or by the government concerned from time to time to apply for admission.</p> <p>As per BCI Rule 28: Age on admission: (a) The maximum age for seeking admission into a stream of integrated Bachelor of law degree program, is limited to twenty years in case of general category of applicants and to twenty two years in case of applicants from SC, ST and other Backward communities.</p>
