The National Testing Agency will be conducting Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)] -2026 **between 11-31 May 2026 (tentative) in Computer Based test (CBT) mode** at different centres located in various cities throughout the country and 15 cities outside India, which provides a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities/ Participating Universities (State/Deemed/Private) across the Country.
