Subject: Declaration of OBC Class for availing Reservation under JEMAS(PG)- 2025

It is hereby notified for information of all concerned candidates of JEMAS(PG)-2025 that an online portal for declaration of OBC Class will remain active from **30-07-2026 to 02-08-2026 (11:59 p.m.)**.

Eligible candidates must log in to the designated portal using their application credentials and declare their respective OBC Class within the stipulated period as appearing in the list notified vide **Gazette Notification No. 945-BCW/MR-23/2026 dated 18.05.2026** (read with **Gazette Notification No. 944-BCW/MR-23/2026 dated 18.05.2026**), as communicated by the Backward Classes Welfare Department, Government of West Bengal vide **No. 957(11)-BCW/MR-23/2026 dated 19.05.2026**, in order to avail the benefit of **7% reservation for OBC**.

Candidates claiming the aforesaid reservation benefit shall be required to produce a valid **original OBC Certificate**, duly issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format and in accordance with the extant Government orders, at the time of counselling/admission and document verification. Failure to produce the requisite original OBC Certificate during counselling/admission and verification of documents shall result in cancellation of the claimed reservation benefit and the candidature shall be considered strictly in accordance with the applicable/extant rules of the Board and the concerned counselling/admission authority.

No request for further declaration, modification or inclusion of OBC Class shall be entertained after closure of the portal as edit option will remain available till the closer of the portal. Therefore, all eligible candidates are advised to complete the declaration process well before the last date.

In terms of the Momo vide **No. 1037(64)/Secy-BCW/MR-33/2025 (Pt.V) dt. 29.05.2026 issued by the Backward Classes Welfare Department, Govt. of West Bengal**, the applicability of OBC Reservation and Non-Creamy Layer (NCL) status in admission will be followed during counselling and admission process.
