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The following corrections/clarifications/modifications are to be applied to the SCOSTA specifications version 1.2b dated March 15, 2002 and subsequent addendum dated January 23, 2003.

- 1. The following paragraph should be inserted in Section 3 (page 4) of SCOSTA specifications 1.2b dated March 15, 2002 after the paragraph "The structure of the file system...command to fail."
- 2. Non-initialized SCOSTA cards will have no file system (including the MF). In this case, the only command that will be permitted to execute will be "CREATE FILE" with File Control Parameters indicating the MF to be created with specified attributes.
- 3. Subsequently the following corrections must be carried out in the addendum dated January 23, 2003.
 - Page 2: Section on "Security Architecture in SCOSTA". First Bullet should just read as the following.
 - Files (EFs, DFs and MF).

The following line should be deleted from this bullet item.

Blank SCOSTA cards will have a pre-existing MF with no security conditions specified for it.
