The 2nd visit of the Project Monitoring Committee (PMC) for CRC Srinagar was conducted on 29th & 30th September 2025 to review the following construction activities therein:

- Academic/ College Building.
- Administrative and Store Building.
- Canteen Building.
- Repair of the false ceiling in Main Building.

Further, the JKPWD has provided U.C. for the above mentioned projects along with request for release of further payments vide their letter no. EE/R&B/Divn/BM/CS/4048-50 dated 01.09.2025. **Annexure – II.**

It is pertinent to mention that there is an urgent and pressing need to complete the construction of the academic building in order to continue the various courses that are being run at CRC Srinagar and also ensure future growth of the Institute.

The summary of PMC recommendations were:

- Out of the tender awarded for Rs.1,64,85,000/-, Rs.40.00 lakhs had been released to JKPWD vide PFMS Transfer no.C062551995061 dated 30.06.2025. *Remaining Rs.1,24,85,000/- may please be considered for release of payment to JKPWD in two installments i.e. Rs.62,00,000/- (1st Installment) + Rs.62,85,000/- (2nd Installment).*
- Utilization certificates should be obtained from the concerned agencies for the Administrative, Canteen and Main Buildings.
- Work completion certificate should be obtained from the concerned agencies for the Administrative, Canteen, and Main Buildings.

The Standing Committee was requested to consider the 2nd PMC report for CRC Srinagar and allow the release of first installment of remaining amount i.e. Rs 62.00 Lakhs to JKPWD in order to continue the truss installation and other civil works.

The Standing Committee **allowed** the release of first instalment of remaining amount i.e. Rs. 62.00 Lakhs to JKPWD in order to continue the truss installation and other civil work on precondition that the complete civil work should be completed in 4 months time. The second instalment shall be considered for release only when the UC and Work Completion certificates have been received for the other civil works as well.

To consider the request from Director CRC Srinagar for utilizing Internal Accrual to meet the immediate infrastructure requirements of the Institute.

The University of Kashmir inspected CRC Srinagar for granting permission to run the various academic programs there. The the O/o Dean College Development Council, Univ. of Kashmir vide letter no F(Inspection-Def-CRC)CDC/KU/25 dated 01.11.2025 highlighted serious deficiencies in faculty, laboratories and basic amenities.

The Director, CRC Srinagar vide letter no. CRC/2025/18/190 dated 10.11.2025 requested that the CRC Srinagar may be allowed to utilize an amount of Rs 37.00 Lakhs from Internal Accrual to meet the urgent and pressing needs of the Institute in order to ensure that the requirements/ guidelines of the University of Kashmir are met/complied with and to ensure that the academic programs being run there do not suffer. The necessary permissions for some of the items were already granted in 143rd Standing Committee meeting as submitted below:
