

Agenda Item No. 145.02	<p><b>To consider perimeter marking and construction of RCC framed boundary wall for the Composite Regional Centre (CRC) Varanasi at Ramnagar, Varanasi.</b></p>
	<p>The Uttar Pradesh Government has allocated 03 acres of land for construction of permanent building of CRC Varanasi at Ramnagar vide letter no. <b>1162/65-1-2025-65-1099/70/2021</b> dated 04.09.2025. The transfer in revenue records was notified vide letter no. <b>C-612 / जिल्हे अधिकारी का नंबर / राज्य अधिकारी का नंबर / 2025-26</b>. <b>दिनांक: 24-09-2025</b>. The possession of land was taken by the Director CRC Varanasi on behalf of DEPwD on 24.10.2025. In order to mark the perimeter of the allotted land and preventing encroachment, the exercise of installing concrete pillars was undertaken as urgent/high priority task on behest of DEPwD at an expenditure of Rs.7,01,1000/-.</p> <p>Further, in reference to CRC Varanasi letter no.CRC/Admin/07/03/CPWD/2025-26/105 dated 14/10/2025, the CPWD has submitted its estimate for construction of RCC framed boundary wall amounting to ₹. 1,30,84,700/=. The estimate includes 3% contingencies and 3.94% ESIC/EPF charges.</p> <p>The Standing Committee was requested to consider and approve:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The work accomplished thus far includes - structural, blockwork, plastering, flooring, door frames installed, granite flooring and ongoing electrical and plumbing work.</p> <p>Till date a total of Rs. 12,02,13,167/- has been released to NBCC of which it has retained Rs 2,97,02,095/- advance as security and released the remaining Rs. 9,05,11,072/- to the contractor.</p>

The University of Kashmir inspected CRC Srinagar for granting permission to run the various academic programs there. The the O/o Dean College Development Council, Univ. of Kashmir vide letter no F(Inspection-Def-CRC)CDC/KU/25 dated 01.11.2025 highlighted serious deficiencies in faculty, laboratories and basic amenities.

The Director, CRC Srinagar vide letter no. CRC/2025/18/190 dated 10.11.2025 requested that the CRC Srinagar may be allowed to utilize an amount of Rs 37.00 Lakhs from Internal Accrual to meet the urgent and pressing needs of the Institute in order to ensure that the requirements/ guidelines of the University of Kashmir are met/complied with and to ensure that the academic programs being run there do not suffer. The necessary permissions for some of the items were already granted in 143<sup>rd</sup> Standing Committee meeting as submitted below:
