INTRODUCTION

Amar Jyoti Institute of Physiotherapy (AJIPT) is an affiliated college of the University of Delhi and operates under the Amar Jyoti Charitable Trust (AJCT). AJCT is an organization working with the mission of providing equal opportunities and full participation to persons with disabilities since its inception in 1981.

AJIPT was established in 1999, with the vision of achieving excellence in physiotherapy education, research, and clinical practice. Since then, the Institute is committed to preparing competent, ethical, and socially responsible healthcare professionals. In 2016, it became the first college under the University of Delhi to launch the Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) programme.

The Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) is a full-time, two-year postgraduate programme that combines advanced classroom instruction with extensive clinical training and research. The curriculum uses case-based learning, seminars, presentations, supervised clinical practice, research activities, and a dissertation to foster evidence-based professional practice.

The programme develops advanced clinical competence, critical and analytical reasoning, research aptitude, teaching ability, and leadership quality in specialized areas of physiotherapy. The students are prepared to serve effectively as clinicians, academicians, researchers, consultants, and healthcare educators across diverse clinical and academic settings.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The Institute is housed in a dedicated academic and clinical facility spread across approximately 58,110 square feet, designed

to support high-quality teaching, learning, research, and patient care activities.

AJIPT provides a comprehensive academic environment supported by well-equipped classrooms, seminar rooms, specialized laboratories, and clinical training facilities. The Institute has a dedicated Electrotherapy, Exercise Therapy & Biomechanics, and Research laboratories that facilitate experiential and evidence-based learning.

The library is modern, computerized, and resource-rich, comprising an extensive collection of books, journals, dissertations, and reference material related to Medical Sciences, Physiotherapy, Rehabilitation, Disability Studies, and Allied Health Sciences. Students also have access to online journals, digital resources, and internet-enabled academic databases to support research and self-directed learning.

The Institute also provides facilities for indoor and outdoor sports activities, student common areas, and a supportive academic atmosphere that encourages professional growth, collaborative learning, and student engagement.

FACULTY

The faculty of AJIPT constitutes one of the Institute's greatest strengths.

The Institute has a team of highly qualified and experienced academicians, clinicians, and researchers specializing in diverse domains of Physiotherapy. The academic team actively contributes towards academic innovation, evidence-based clinical practice, and scientific research.

The Institute also benefits from the expertise of distinguished visiting faculty and medical professionals from various specialties who enrich the academic

experience through interdisciplinary teaching and clinical interaction.

Faculty members regularly guide students in seminars, research projects, dissertations, journal discussions, and supervised clinical teaching activities aimed at developing critical thinking, professional competence, and leadership qualities among postgraduate students.

COURSES OFFERED

The Institute runs a 5-years graduate program, Bachelor of Physiotherapy and a 2-years post graduate program, Master of Physiotherapy in two specialties.

- **Musculoskeletal Sciences:** It includes advanced management of musculoskeletal disorders, sports injuries, orthopaedic rehabilitation, manual therapy, and exercise prescription.
- **Neurological Sciences:** It includes management of neuro-rehabilitation across the lifespan—stroke, spinal cord injury, cerebral palsy, neurodegenerative disorders, vestibular and movement disorders.

MASTER OF PHYSIOTHERAPY

Programme structure and learning methods

The curriculum combines advanced classroom teaching with case-based learning, problem-based tutorials, interactive seminars, practical laboratory sessions, and supervised clinical rotations.

Students engage in structured clinical placements across a range of settings—outpatient departments, inpatient wards, specialty clinics, and community outreach to develop comprehensive assessment and treatment skills.

Regular journal clubs, case presentations, microteaching, and multidisciplinary case conferences promote critical appraisal of evidence and collaborative care.

Communication, teaching, professional ethics, and patient-education skills are developed through simulated practice sessions and supervised, student-led instruction.

Research, dissertation, and scholarly activities

Research methodology, biostatistics, critical appraisal, and research ethics are core components of the programme, taught through workshops and applied research exercises.

Each student undertakes an original research project under the mentorship of experienced faculty and submits a dissertation as a requirement for degree completion.

Ongoing faculty-led research, opportunities for conference presentations, and encouragement for publication enable students to contribute to scientific knowledge and evidence-based practice.

Competencies and Outcomes

On completion of the course, students will be able to:

- Demonstrate advanced clinical reasoning and highly skilled assessment and intervention across their chosen specialty.
- Apply current best evidence to clinical decision-making and adapt management to individual patient needs.
- Design and conduct ethically sound research, interpret findings, and translate evidence into practice.
- Teach and mentor undergraduate students and peers, and contribute to continuing professional development.
- Exhibit professional, ethical, and interprofessional behaviours suitable for complex healthcare environments.

Assessment and Quality Assurance

Student performance is assessed through written and practical examinations, continuous clinical appraisal, assignments, presentations, research progress reviews, and the final dissertation evaluation.

The programme follows academic standards and periodic curriculum review of University of Delhi and National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP) to align with national and international best practices in physiotherapy education.

Career pathways

- Clinical specialist roles in hospitals, rehabilitation centres, sports medicine clinics, and community health programmes.
- Academic and teaching positions in physiotherapy education and allied health programmes.

- Research careers in academic institutions, clinical research organisations, and public health settings.
- Consultancy, programme management, and leadership positions within multidisciplinary healthcare teams.

Professional values and interdisciplinary practice

The programme emphasises ethical practice, patient-centred care, cultural sensitivity, and collaborative work with physicians, nurses, occupational therapists, speech therapists, and other healthcare professionals.

Students are trained to prioritise safe, equitable, and evidence-informed services that meet patient and contemporary healthcare needs.

How the Institute supports students

- Experienced faculty provide mentorship for clinical learning and research development.
- Access to well-equipped laboratories, simulation facilities, and diverse clinical placement sites ensures comprehensive training.
- Academic and career counselling, research support, and opportunities for interdepartmental collaboration help students transition successfully into professional roles.

Admissions and Accreditation

Entry requires a Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) degree from a recognized University and fulfilment of NCAHP eligibility criteria. Selection is based on merit in Common University Entrance Test-Post Graduate (CUET-PG) entrance examination.

On successful completion of the programme and fulfilment of all academic

and clinical requirements, the University of Delhi awards the degree of Master of Physiotherapy (MPT) in the chosen specialization.

ELIGIBILITY

Candidates seeking admission to the Master of Physiotherapy programme should have successfully completed a Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT) or B.Sc. (Physiotherapy) degree of minimum 4½ years duration, including compulsory internship, from a recognized institution/university with at least 50% (General category and EWS) and 40% (SC, ST, OBC-NCL, and PwBD) aggregate marks in the qualifying examination. Candidates who have completed a 3½ year programme along with an additional bridge course of one year shall also be considered equivalent to a 4½ year programme.

Registration with the Delhi Council for Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy (DCPTOT) is mandatory for admission. Candidates who have applied for DCPTOT registration must submit proof of application at the time of counselling/admission and produce the registration certificate subsequently as required.

DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS 2026-27

The Seat distribution for MPT (Musculoskeletal and Neurological Sciences) Admission 2026-27 is as follows:

One seat in the specialization of MPT Neurological Sciences shall be reserved under the 5% reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD).

*In the absence of an eligible candidate, these seats will be converted to the Unreserved (UR) category.

**The allocation of seats across specialities will be alternated annually.

Relevant caste/ EWS/ Disability certificates, issued by the competent authority in the prescribed format, must be submitted at the time of counselling/admission.

**SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS
SCHEDULED CASTE/ SCHEDULED
TRIBE/ OTHER BACKWARD CLASS-
NON CREAMY CANDIDATES**

A Scheduled Caste/Tribe candidate while applying for admission will be required to submit a certificate to the effect that he/she belongs to that particular category from a competent authority along with the application form. OBC-NCL (Non Creamy Layer) candidates should have an OBC-NCL certificate valid for 2026-27. The caste mentioned in the OBC certificate should be mentioned in the central list of OBC available at: <http://ncbc.nc.in/backwardclasses.indeed.htm/> In case a candidate has applied for renewal of NCL certificate for the year 2026-27 at the time of application, he/she needs to submit the NCL certificate of the previous year along with a proof of application (receipt). All the OBC-NCL candidates must submit valid NCL certificate for the year 2026- 27 at the time of counselling.

Person with Benchmark Disability (PwBD) Candidates

Candidates seeking admission in PwBD category should have a valid disability certificate/ Unique Disability Identity (UDID) Card issued by a competent

Economically Weaker Section (EWS) Candidates

Candidates seeking admission under the EWS category must have a valid certificate issued by the competent authority on or after 1st April 2026 (for the financial year 2026-27).

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR MPT

Admission to the MPT programme will be strictly merit-based on the CUET-PG 2026 entrance examination conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA). The Institute, in coordination with Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya National Institute for Persons with Physical Disabilities, will manage the admission and counselling process for the 2026–27 academic session using CUET-PG 2026 scores.

Please note: As per University of Delhi directives, admissions will no longer be processed through the Postgraduate Common Seat Allocation System (PG-CSAS). Candidates must therefore apply directly via the joint admission portal <https://pdunipd.nic.in>

Admission Process

The admission process shall be conducted in a transparent and merit-based manner and shall involve the following stages:

1. Online application

Eligible candidates seeking admission to the MPT programme shall submit an online application through the Postgraduate Admission Portal <https://pdunipd.nic.in>

Applicants are required to:

- Fill the online application form carefully
- Upload all required documents
- Provide CUET-PG 2026 details accurately
- Submit the application within the prescribed deadline

Submission of an application does not automatically guarantee admission.

2. Eligibility verification

Applications received shall be scrutinized to verify eligibility as per NCAHP norms.

Candidates must ensure that they fulfill all eligibility requirements regarding:

- Educational qualification
- Internship completion
- Minimum qualifying marks
- Registration with Delhi Council for Physiotherapy and Occupational Therapy (DCPTOT)
- Category certificates, wherever applicable

Applications found incomplete or ineligible shall be rejected.

3. Preparation of merit list

A merit list shall be prepared on the basis of CUET-PG 2026 scores.

The merit list shall include only those candidates who:

- Apply within the stipulated period
- Fulfill all eligibility conditions
- Submit complete and valid documentation

The merit list shall be displayed on the Institute website. If CUET-PG scores are identical, candidates' BPT aggregate marks will be used to determine ranking.

It is the responsibility of the candidate to check the website regularly for updates.

4. Physical counselling

Counselling for admission shall be conducted physically at the Institute campus.

Candidates shortlisted in the merit list shall be required to appear in person for counselling on the notified date and time.

During counselling:

- Candidates shall be considered strictly in order of merit.
- Seat allocation shall be done according to:
 - Candidate merit
 - Availability of seats
 - Specialization preference indicated by the candidate at the time of counselling
 - Applicable reservation norms

Candidates who fail to report for counselling at the scheduled time will forfeit their claim for admission.

5. Document Verification

Candidates must produce original documents along with self-attested photocopies at the time of counselling.

The following documents shall be required:

- CUET-PG 2026 Score Card
- Admit Card of CUET-PG 2026
- Class X Certificate (Date of Birth proof)
- Class XII Mark sheet and Certificate
- BPT/B.Sc. (PT) Degree Certificate
- Consolidated Mark Sheets of qualifying examination
- Internship Completion Certificate

- DCPTOT Registration Certificate or proof of registration application
- Migration Certificate (where applicable)
- Category Certificate (SC/ST/OBC-NCL/EWS/PwBD), if applicable
- 4 Passport-size photographs
- Valid Government-issued photo identity proof
- Character Certificate from competent authority

The Institute reserves the right to verify the authenticity of all submitted documents.

Admission shall stand cancelled if any information or document is found false, incomplete, or misleading.

6. Payment of fees

Candidates allotted seats shall be required to deposit one year's course fee on the day of the counselling.

Failure to deposit fees shall result in cancellation of the allotted seat, and the seat may be offered to the next eligible candidate.

GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

Any grievance related to admission, counselling, merit, reservation, or seat allocation may be submitted to the designated Grievance Redressal Committee within the prescribed timeline at diriph@nic.in and cc to info@ajipt.org

The decision of the admission committee and the competent authority of the Institute regarding admissions shall be final and binding.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- Admission to the MPT programme is strictly subject to fulfillment of

eligibility conditions prescribed by the University of Delhi and regulatory authorities.

- Candidates are advised to regularly visit the Institute website for updates and notifications regarding admissions and counselling.
- The Institute reserves the right to modify, amend, or update any admission-related information, schedule, rules, or procedures whenever considered necessary.
- Mere appearance in counselling or inclusion in the merit list does not guarantee admission.
- All admissions shall remain provisional until final verification and approval by the University of Delhi and other competent authorities.

ADMISSION WITHDRAWAL POLICY

- Application for withdrawal to be submitted as a hard copy in the AJIPT Office.
- Only applications endorsed by parents / guardian will be accepted.
- Original fee receipt is mandatory for refund.
- Application made prior to commencement of course (orientation day) will be eligible for reimbursement of full course fee EXCEPT admission fee.
- Application made after commencement of the course (orientation day) will NOT BE eligible for any reimbursement of the course fee
