RREPORT ON WORLD CEREBRAL PALSY DAY

Date 18th November 2025

The Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation and Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (CRCSRE), Imphal observed **World Cerebral Palsy Day** on 18th October 2025 at the CRCSRE Hall under the theme “*Unique and United.*”



The programme was presided over by **Shri N. Khoibi Singh**, Director, CRCSRE Imphal, and graced by **Shri Waikhom Birahari**, State Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities, Government of Manipur, as the Chief Guest. The event also saw the presence of **Dr. Rahul Oinam**, Consultant Neurologist, Shija Hospitals & Research Institute Pvt. Ltd., and **Dr. Jasowanta Singh**, Board Member, National Trust, Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Government of India, as Guests of Honour.
