1. ABOUT NATIONAL COUNCIL FOR HOTEL MANAGEMENT AND CATERING TECHNOLOGY

National Council for Hotel Management and Catering Technology (NCHMCT) was established by Ministry of Tourism, Government of India in the year 1982 to co-ordinate and regulate the growth and general advancement in the development of hospitality management education through its affiliated Institutes. The Council has been responsible in providing professional and skilled human capital to the hotel and tourism industry through its programs.

In 2002 onwards, NCHMCT is offering the 3-Years Bachelor Degree programme in Hospitality and Hotel Administration (B.Sc.HHA) and 02 years Post Graduate programme on Hospitality Administration (M.Sc. HA). These two Academic Programs are recognised by **Jawaharlal Nehru University(JNU)**, **New Delhi** to award Degree to the pass out students of these programs.

As on date, **21** Central Institute of Hotel Management, **28** State Institute of Hotel Management, **1** PSU Institute of Hotel Management, **24** Private Hotel Management Institutes and **13** Food Craft Institutes are under the academic umbrella of NCHMCT and offering the above programs.

About 95% of the graduates are employed by Hospitality and other service sectors through on-campus and off-campus recruitment processes.

3. Program Details and Admission Procedures of B.Sc.(HHA) Progamme

3.1 About the Programme :

This programme equips the students with the required skills, knowledge and attitude to efficiently discharge supervisory responsibilities in the Hospitality sector. This programme covers in-depth laboratory work for students to acquire required knowledge and skill standards in the operational areas of Food Production, Food & Beverage Service, Front Office Operation and House Keeping. In addition it provides managerial inputs in Hotel Accountancy, Food Safety & Quality, Human Resource Management, Facility Planning, Financial Management, Strategic Management, Tourism Marketing and Management.

The B.Sc.HHA program (Generic & Vegetarian) is available in all the affiliated Institute of Hotel Management those who are interested in vegetarian only. The Theory part will be common to all and practical session will be conducted separately for vegetarian.

3.2 Duration of the Programme :

B.Sc. (Hospitality and Hotel Administration) programme is of 03 years durations but one can complete it in maximum of 04 years.

3.3 Eligibility :

For Indian Nationals :

- A pass in 10+2 system of Senior Secondary examination or its equivalent with English as one of the subjects. Candidate must have passed English as a subject of study (core/elective/functional) in the qualifying examination.
- > Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/ University.
- Those appearing in 10+2 or equivalent examination can also appear on provisional basis. However, the individual should submit the proof for qualifying the examination by **30th September** of the admission year.

COMMON QUALIFYING EXAMINATIONS FOR INDIAN STUDENTS

- Plus two level examination in the 10+2 pattern of Senior Secondary education of any recognized Central/State Board, such as Central Board of Secondary Education and Council for Indian School Certificate Examination or State Boards of Secondary Education.
- > Intermediate or two-year Pre-University Examination conducted by a recognized Board/ University.
- General Certificate Education (GCE) Examination (London/Cambridge/Sri Lanka) at the Advanced (A) level.
- > High School Certificate Examination of the Cambridge University.
- Any Public School/Board/University Examination in India or in a foreign country recognized by the Association of Indian Universities as equivalent to 10+2 pattern of Senior Secondary education.
- > H.S.C. Vocational Examination approved by NCVT and SCVT of concerned state.

Senior Secondary School Examination conducted by the National Institute of Open Schooling with a minimum of five subjects including English as one of the passing subject, result of which should be available up to 30.09.2023.

3.4 Age Limit:

There is no age bar from this year.

3.5 Medical Fitness :

All qualified candidates will have to submit a medical fitness certificate of carrying out practical claims as required in course at the time of admission from a Registered Medical Practitioner in the prescribed format given at – **Annexure -1**

3.6 Admission Procedure :

Through NCHM JEE :

The admission to the B.Sc. HHA programme in the affiliated institute of NCHMCT through NCHM JEE. The NCHM JEE is conducted by NTA (National Testing Agency is an organisation under Min. of Education, Govt. of India) for all Indian nationals. The examination Fees, Scheme, Pattern of Exam, Centre, Guidelines, etc details are available in the information bulletin of NTA website (<u>https://nchmjee.nta.nic.in</u>).

Admission after the JEE is through the centralised Counselling process, in which the Institute are allotted on the basis of All India Rank achieved in the NCHM JEE and the choice of Institute filled by the candidate during the Counselling process. Therefore, to get admission in an Institute, one has to participate in the Counselling process after qualifying the NCHM JEE. NCHM Counselling website is <u>https://nchmcounselling.nic.in</u>.

3.7 Reservations for Seat Allotment:

a. NCHMCT is following the reservation policy of Govt. of India, **to fill the seats for the above programme in the affiliated Govt. Institutes** as given below along with merit list of NCHM JEE Results.

EWS (General)	-	10%
OBC (NCL)	-	27%
SC	-	15%
ST	-	7.5%

b. For PWD Candidates : 5% of the total seats will be reserved for the candidates with 40% or more disability as defined in the Persons with Disabilities Act 2016. However, such candidate should be able to carry out all required practical as prescribed in the program as mentioned Annexure 1.1 (For Practical class work)

Practical to be carried by a student during the course duration:

- i. Cutting/ Chopping of all vegetables and other items prior to cooking;
- ii. Cooking of four items in each practical classes in the Basic Training Kitchen and Advance Training kitchen;
- iii. Cooking of Indian menu for lunch at bulk quantity as part of the team member;
- iv. All work in bakery and Confectionary section;
- v. Service of Food and Beverages, flammable in the Training Restaurants;

- vi. Flower arrangement, Bed making, cleaning, stain removing, washing (in machine), Ironing and use of calendaring machine, floor moping, handling of vacuum cleaner, handling of floor cleaning/ polishing machine etc;
- vii. Computer operation, Rooms reservation through dedicated software.

c. Reservation for Kashmiri Migrant (subject to notification from Ministry of Education)- one supernumerary seat in each Govt. Institute.

3.8 Merit List:

All India merit list of candidates shall be prepared on the basis of marks secured in the NCHM-JEE. In case more than one candidate secured equal marks, the merit will be determined as under;

- i) Candidate securing higher marks in English component of JEE shall rank higher,
- ii) In case of candidates securing equal aggregate marks in NCHM-JEE, as well as in English component of NCHM-JEE, then the candidate securing higher marks in Service Aptitude Component of NCHM-JEE shall rank higher,
- iii) In case of tie in (i) and (ii) above, the candidate older in age shall rank higher.

Result of NCHM JEE shall be announced by the NTA's at: <u>www.nchmjee.nta.nic.in</u> and by NCHMCT at: <u>www.nchmcounselling.nic.in</u>

3.9 COUNSELLING & OTHER ADMISSION PROCEDURES

3.9.1 ALLOTMENT OF SEATS THROUGH COUNSELLING

There shall be four rounds of Counselling (Online) on the basis of NCHM JEE merit (All India Rank) for eligible candidates only. The detailed process of Counselling shall be available in the website **www.nchmcounselling.nic.in** after declaration of result of **NCHM-JEE 2023**.

Eligible candidate from the merit list of NCHM JEE, to participate in the Counselling process, have to register and pay one time non-refundable registration fees for Rs 2,000 in the <u>www.nchmcounselling.nic.in</u> portal.

3.9.2 First Round

- (a) The registered candidate will opt their choices of institutes in first round as per schedule. The candidate may select their choice institute one or more. Each candidate must fill choices carefully the candidate must select only those Institutes in the choices, in which the candidate is willing to join and the sequence should be best choice first and so on. The seat will be allotted based on their NCHM JEE All India Rank, Reservation Category and choice / preference of choice of Institute opted by the candidate by the online system.
- (b) Those who are allotted the seat in first round, as per the candidate's choice, the candidate has to confirm the seat on payment of Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF) of Rs.20,000/- and by uploading the required documents for online Document Verification by Document Verification Centre (DVC). The SAF of Rs.20,000/- is the part of first semester fee and accordingly be sent to the finally allotted Institute after Counselling process is over and if not withdrawn by the candidate.
- (c) Those who got allotted seat in the first round and not deposited the Seat Acceptance Fee in the Counselling schedule for first round, the allotted seat will automatically be cancelled and the candidate will be eligible to participate in the next rounds against the available vacant seats only.

- (d) Those who are allotted seat in first round, accepted the seat by following the formalities as mentioned in (b) above, but is interested to upgrade the choice of Institute in subsequent round should opt for <u>"floating"</u> option and not opt to <u>"freeze"</u>.
- (e) The candidate completed the formality as above with floating option may even revise their choice of Institutes in the subsequent round. In case allotment in first round is made in an Institute other than 1st choice and opted for "floating" for next round, at the same time not revised the choices, allotment in subsequent round will be considered within the earlier choices and availability of seats. In case of upgradation, the candidate need not to go for either to deposit SAF or further verification of document. But the fresh allotment letter should be downloaded for record. Once the allotment is upgraded, earlier allotted seat will be cancelled automatically and the candidate will not have any claim in the earlier allotted seat.
- (f) Candidate who have been deposited Seat Acceptance Fee in first round of Counselling but not completed the document verification process towards seat confirmation, such seat will automatically be cancelled. They will be eligible to participate in subsequent rounds and the fees already deposited will be adjusted, if participated, otherwise will be refunded.
- (g) If seat is allotted and the candidate is not fulfilling the eligible criteria like educational qualification, etc. such seat will automatically be cancelled. The SAF amount, if deposited, will be refunded.
- (h) If any candidate registered in the first round and allotted seat but not able to produce the 12th Pass certificate during document verification, having sufficient other proof of appeared the exam from a recognised board, will have to furnish a written undertaking of submitting original 12th certificate by 30th September of the admission year at the allotted Institute. In case of failure to do so by the due date, or got compartment in 12th, the allotted seat will be cancelled and there will be no refund.
- (i) If any candidate registered in the first round and allotted seat based on his/her category applied but not able to produce the category certificate during document verification, having sufficient other proof of belong to the same category, will have to furnish a written undertaking of submitting original category certificate by 30th September of the admission year at the allotted Institute. In case of failure to do so by the due date, the allotted seat will be cancelled and there will be no refund.
- (j) If any candidate registered in the first round and allotted seat based on his/her category applied but not found belong to the said category during document verification, will be converted into open category or to the actual category, the candidate may participate in the subsequent rounds of counselling under actual category.
- (k) If any candidate allotted, accepted and confirmed the seat in the first round of counselling but withdraw seat during the stipulated date through online in the portal (during the first-round counselling), the seat as well as the registration for the counselling will be cancelled. Such candidate will not be allowed in subsequent rounds except Fourth (Final) round. However, the SAF of Rs.20,000/-, if deposited, will be adjusted in subsequent rounds.
- (I) If seat is not allotted in this round, the candidate may participate in the subsequent rounds, for which no further registration fees will be required.
- (m) If the candidates not lock/freeze the seat, it may be treated as floating to the next rounds to upgrade, subject to availability of seat. Once the allotment is upgraded, earlier allotted seat will be cancelled automatically and the candidate will not have any claim in the earlier allotted seat.

3.9.3 Second and Third Round

- (a) Candidates, who have not registered and not participated in earlier rounds of Counselling, can registered by depositing the registration fee of Rs.2000/- through the portal and participate in the second / third round of counselling against the available vacant seats.
- (b) Candidates, who have already registered in first round by depositing the registration fee of Rs.2000/through the portal and not participated in earlier rounds of Counselling, can participate in the second / third round of counselling against the available vacant seats.
- (c) Seat allotment in any subsequent round will be in the similar condition as mentioned in first round of Counselling.
- (d) If any better rank (AIR of NCHM JEE) candidate, who, has not participated in first round of counselling, will not have any right to claim against such a seat allotted to a lower rank candidate (who participated and got seat on merit in the first round of counselling and fixed the seat).
- (e) Before filling the choice during second or subsequent rounds, the candidates are advised to view the vacancy position of seats in the Institutes after first / second rounds allotment in the portal.
- (f) Candidates who have given floating option after acceptance of first round allotted seat, will also be allowed to participate in second round for up-gradation or even choice modification but need not to go for document verification process exercise. But the fresh allotment letter should be downloaded for record. Once the allotment is upgraded, earlier allotted seat will be cancelled automatically and the candidate will not have any claim in the earlier allotted seat.
- (g) If seat is not allotted in these rounds, the candidate may participate in the subsequent rounds and the registration fees will be carry forwarded.
- (h) If the candidates not lock/freeze the seat, it may be treated as floating to the further rounds to upgrade, subject to availability of seat. Once the allotment is upgraded, earlier allotted seat will be cancelled automatically and the candidate will not have any claim in the earlier allotted seat.
- (i) Candidates allotted seat in first, second and third rounds, want to withdraw/ surrender the allotted seat can do so only through online mode in the Counselling portal only before starting of Registration in the Final Round. No manual or by post or by email withdrawal will be entertained. Any withdrawal/ surrender of seat after that above said date will forfeit the SAF.

3.9.4 Final Round of Counselling for JEE qualified Candidates:-

- a. Candidates should note that, Fourth round is the final round of Admission on All India JEE Rank basis and there will be no further round of Counselling for seat allotment under this parameter.
- b. Candidate participated in earlier rounds, allotted, accepted and finalised the seat, but want to participate in Final Round against available vacant seats, may also to do so. In case of non-allotment a seat in this round, the earlier allotted seat will retain. But, once the earlier allotment is upgraded, earlier allotted seat will be cancelled automatically and the candidate will not have any claim in the earlier allotted seat.
- c. Candidates, who have not registered and not participated in First/Second/Third rounds of Counselling, can registered by depositing the registration fee of Rs.2000/- through the portal. It is being the Final Round and there is no withdrawal, the candidate has to deposit SAF Rs. 20000 to get link to fill the choice in this round against the vacant seats. Seat allotment process in this round will be the similar as mentioned in first and subsequent rounds of Counselling, except withdrawal/ surrender of seat.
- d. No withdrawal/ Surrender of seat, no refund during or after this round.

3.10 Refund Rules

- a. Registration fee of Rs.2000 to participate in the Counselling Process is non-refundable, however it should be paid one time.
- b. A candidate, who has already accepted a seat in First, Second or Third Round of Counselling can withdraw the allotted seat by reporting online in Counselling portal and following the steps therein during each round. This option will be available up to the end of 3rd round only. Such candidate will get refund 100% of Seat Acceptance Fee (SAF) of Rs.20000/-.
- c. No refund, if not withdrawn through online Counselling portal.
- d. There is no option of withdraw of an accepted/ allotted seat after the third round of Counselling is over.
- e. A candidate only participated in Final round, deposited SAF to fill choice but not allotted any seat in Final round, or allotted seat in the round but cancelled due to not eligible, will get refund of 100% of SAF.
- f. In case, participated in only final round, seat allotted and found eligible, **no refund**, even if not accepted the seat or want to withdraw from the seat.
- g. A candidate wants to withdraw/ surrender seat, who got allotted and accepted seat in any earlier rounds and also participated in the Final round but not upgraded the seat in final round (in such case earlier seat will retain), will not get any refund.
- h. Refund, if any, will be made by the Council directly in the Bank Account mentioned during online withdraw through the portal, within 45 days from the date of commencement of Academic Session (AS) for the newly admitted batch. This year tentative date of commencement of AS is 7th August, 2023.
- i. Candidate can apply for fee refund (NCHM Part), upto 31st March, 2024 only.

3.11 Inter – Institute Transfer / Migration

National Council does not allow inter-institute transfer or migration on any ground during the entire duration of the course since the allotment of Institute is done on merit-cum-choice only. No request for transfer or migration will be entertained after allotment of seat.

4. Fees Structures

4.1 Fees Structures (for Government sponsored Institutes)

- Candidates allotted seat through NCHM JEE should make rest of the fee of first semester to the allotted Institute excluding the Seat Acceptance Fee of Rs. 20,000.
- **There is no concession in fee for Reserved Category students**. However, they may avail the Scholarship from respective Government/ Scholarship granting authority.
- Caution money, locker fee, library fee and other charges, if any will be charged by the Institute, which will have to be paid separately after reporting to the finally allotted Institute.

1. Since, the NEP will start from 2023-24 academic year, those who will opt for four years degree, for them, the fee for 4th Year will be as same as prescribed for 3rd Year +NCHM Enrolment Fee Rs.1000/-.

2. However, the cities in India have been divided in three categories according to the status of the city. The IHMs located in A and B category cities, have been given discretion of charging higher rate of tuition fee. The categorization of the cities and the maximum discretion of charging increased tuition fee is as under.

4.2 Fees Structures (for Private affiliated Institutes)

- Private Affiliated Institutes have the discretion to charge higher rate of tuition fee, not more than double of the standard tuition fee as stated in 4.1 above.
- Candidate are advised to obtain the fee structure, inclusive of other Institutional/ Activity fee of respective Institute from their websites.
- At the same time, make aware of the availability of Hostel and Hostel Mess Charge of the private Institute.
