**Minutes of meeting of Project of Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (PS&MC) held on 29.7.2016 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Department of Land Resources (DoLR) in Committee Room, NBO Building, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi**

\*\*\*\*\*

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary on 29<sup>th</sup> July, 2016 at 3:00 PM to consider the proposals of the State Governments/UT. The meeting was attended by the representative of States of Assam, Rajasthan, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Chandigarh, NIC and Jamia Millia Islamia University. The meeting was also attended by Project Sanctioning and Monitoring Committee (PS&MC) Members. The list of the participants is annexed.

2. Secretary (LR) welcomed the participants and informed that the matter related to EFC for DILRMP and revision in cost norms are under consideration and hence only those components of the proposals may be considered where a) the specific component was already eligible for 100% Central assistance and b) there is no proposal to enhance the quantum of assistance. Other components will have to be kept pending for the time being.
3. Regarding Aadhaar seeding, the Committee may perhaps consider the proposals only to the extent of level of assistance proposed in the EFC memo, but to be spent by the State Government from their own funds and/or unspent funds, until EFC is approved. This special dispensation will be useful in pursuing the task emphasized by Hon'ble Prime Minister during the Pragati Meeting held in March, 2016.
4. Secretary (LR) also informed the States that the 100% central assistance will only be admissible for the sanctioned components where the work has not been started as on 1.4.2016 and the unspent balance is lying with the States. He invited the States/UTs to present their proposals.
  - 4.1. **Assam** - Shri A. K. Barman, Joint Secretary and Director of Land Records represented Govt. of Assam and submitted their proposal for Computerization of Land Records. The Committee approved their proposal as per Annexure - I.
  - 4.2. **Haryana** - District Collector, Gurgaon represented the State and submitted the proposal for Rs.86.50 crore for Aadhaar Seeding in the land record data in the State of Haryana. The Proposal has been kept pending till EFC is approved with the direction to revise the proposal in line with EFC proposed norms. The State Government may however proceed in accordance with suggestion at para 3 above, if it so wishes.
  - 4.3. **Rajasthan** - Shri Alok Kumar, Secretary, Government of Rajasthan presented his proposal for Computerization of Registration and State Level Data Centre. He also requested the Committee to provide the funds for Modern Record Rooms and the State may be allowed using unspent balance for remaining 22 districts by way of inter districts and inter component transfer. The Committee considered the request and allowed the Govt. of Rajasthan to utilize the funds for remaining 22 districts out of the unspent balance and approved the establishment of State Level Data Centre.

- 4.4. **Tamil Nadu** – Ms. R. Vasuki, Director of Land Records and Shri Ponnuraj, represented the State of Tamil Nadu. Their proposal for Tehsil Data Centre for 14 New Talukas and additional NLRMP Cell at Chennai were considered and approved as per Annexure-I.
- 4.5. **Uttar Pradesh** - Shri Dheeraj Sahu, Secretary, Govt. of Uttar Pradesh presented the proposal in respect of Digitization of Cadastral Maps and the balance amount for two NLRMP Cells. He requested that the work of digitization has not yet started and requested for sanctioning the amount @ Rs.1496.64 per map sheet. He also stated that the work on NLRMP Cell has also not started and state may be given the grant on enhanced rates. The Committee considered the proposal and sanctioned the amount as per Annexure-I.
- 4.6. **NLRMP Cell** – The NIC and Jamia Millia Islamia University presented the proposals of the NLRMP Cell for capacity building to the stakeholders. Since NIC is directly associated with DoLR, the proposal was considered and sanctioned by the Committee with the direction to indicate a suitable place for setting up of NLRMP Cell. In so far as Jamia Millia Islamia University is concerned, the Committee opined that Department of Land Resources is considering the network of the Institutions for training to be imparted and University of Jamia Millia Islamia will be considered as one of the institutions for this purpose.
- 4.7. **Project Management Unit (PMU)** – The UT of Chandigarh, Assam, NIC and Jamia Millia Islamia University requested for PMU at their place. The PMU at Jamia Millia Islamia could not be considered as per the NLRMP guidelines. The Committee considered the proposals and approved the PMU to UT of Chandigarh, State of Assam and NIC under DoLR.
5. The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
