Subject: Central Sector Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) – Release of grants during F.Y 2022-23 for the component of Digitization of Cadastral Maps, Modern Record Room, Core GIS and Computerization of Revenue Courts and Integration with Revenue Officers to the State Govt. of West Bengal – reg.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to PSMC meeting held on 5.8.2022 on the above mentioned subject and to convey the approval of the competent authority towards release of **Rs. 513.745 lakh (Rs. Five Crore Thirteen Lakh Seventy Four Thousand and Five Hundred Only) as 1st Installment (25% of Rs 2054.98lakh)** for the following components to State Govt of West Bengal under DILRMP as per detailed below:

2. The approval of the grant is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The DILRMP shall be implemented as per the Guidelines of the Programme.

- II. 2nd Installment (Rs. **513.745** Lakh) will be released only after due confirmation of expenditure of 75% of 1st Installment by the State Government along with the Utilization Certificate in due time.
- III. The State Govt. will strictly adhere to financial and purchase of service norms of the Central / State Govt. in vogue, suggestion / remarks given by NIC as well as norms prescribed by NICS for hiring manpower etc.
- IV. The State Government must follow the prescribed procedure for purchase of the approved items.
- V. Fund shall be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned. No diversion of funds is permissible.
- VI. The State Government shall submit item-wise expenditure and physical progress and utilization certificate separately for project fund, / PMU/ DILRMP Cell in the prescribed proforma in respect of the funds released under the scheme.
- VII. The State Government should ensure that expenditure is incurred only on approved activities as per the guidelines and circulars issued from DoLR from time to time.
- VIII. The State should follow REAT Module of Public Financial Management System (PFMS) and register the vendors immediately, if not already done for future releases under DILRMP.
- IX. **The fund sanctioned under SC/ST component shall be spent in SC/ST dominated areas and their records should be maintained separately (e.g. village wise, Scheduled Block wise, no of persons benefited, etc.) and may be shared with DoLR.**
- X. **The State is requested to give adequate publicity about the DILRMP and its components. The programme assistance by 'Department of Land Resource, Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India' may be given due recognition during foundation stone laying/inauguration/important meetings etc., wherever applicable.**

3. All the activities sanctioned under the programme shall be completed by the State Government within the financial year 2022-23.

4. The aforesaid release of **Rs 513.745 lakh** will be met from the sanctioned budget grant for the year 2022-23 under Demand No. 88 - Department of Land Resources as per the details given below:
