Monthly Summary of important activities of Department of Land Resources during August, 2023.

1. **‘National Media Campaign’** of Department of Land Resources was launched by Hon’ble Minister of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj on 11th August, 2023 in Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi. The Department is undertaking a pan India Campaign focusing on the Schemes namely Digital India Land Records Modernisation Programme (DILRMP) and Watershed Development component of Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY 2.0). The purpose is to make the general public aware about its programmes/schemes, new initiatives & achievements and also to enhance the people’s participation in its activities. The first phase of the Campaign includes Outdoor Media, Social Media, Bulk SMS and Radio Jingle components. One Crore SMS were sent to citizens on 11th August, 2023 and Hoardings/banners on schemes are being displayed at various places such as Railway Station, Bus Stand, Airports and other prominent places across the country w.r.t. National Generic Document Registration System (NGDRS), WDC-PMKSY and Cactus plantation for awareness and wider publicity.
2. **The 10th meeting of the National Monitoring Committee (NMC) for Rehabilitation and Resettlement** was held under the chairmanship of Secretary (LR) on 10.08.2023. The members/ representatives from the States/UT of Andhra Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, J&K and NCT of Delhi participated in the meeting. The NMC deliberated status of rehabilitation and resettlement of families displaced due to Polavaram Irrigation Project, Ken-Betwa Link Project and JUH Project and issued directions to the concerned authorities for taking timely action. The issues contained in the representation made by Dr. P. Pullarao on behalf of the affected families of the Polavaram Irrigation Project were resolved amicably. The NMC approved engagement of two Expert Associate to advise the Committee as per the provisions of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013.
3. **National Generic Document Registration System (NGDRS) or e-Registration** has been rolled out in NCT of Delhi in the month of August 2023. Thus, NGDRS has now been adopted and rolled out/ implemented in 18 States/UTs. In addition, 12 States/UTs are sharing the data through API/UI.
4. **2nd National Level Technical Committee (NLTC) meeting of World Bank assisted REWARD programme** was held on 10.08.2023 under the Chairmanship of Chief Executive Officer (CEO), NRAA at PUSA, New Delhi. Joint Secretary (WM), Senior Additional Commissioner (WD) & NPMU Experts participated in the meeting.
5. A review meeting on the progress of **WDC-PMKSY** of UP and Maharashtra was held under the chairmanship of Secretary, DoLR. Two review meetings under WDC-PMKSY 2.0 were held by the Department on Expenditure, MIS, Amrit Sarovar and other issues on WDC-PMKSY with the CEOs of concerned States/UTs through VC.

6. A meeting was held by the Department with Executive Member, Khasi Hills Autonomous District Council (KHADC), Meghalaya regarding implementation of DILRMP in KHADC and other issues.

7. Department of Land Resources was ranked among the Top five Departments by the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DAR&PG) for July, 2023 on disposal of Public Grievances.

8. The Department issued instructions for hoisting National Flags to all employees at their residence on the eve of 'Independence Day' on 15th August, 2023 as per the direction from Ministry of Culture. In addition, a Selfie-point was erected at 'NBO Building' for taking selfie with the National Flag on 14.08.2022. Photographs/selfies of the Officers/Officials were uploaded on 'Har GharTiranga' portal and widely circulated on social media platforms.

9. Under Watershed Development Component of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY), 6376 projects have been completed till date out of the total 6382 projects {8214 (Sanctioned) - 1832 (Transferred to State)}. End line evaluation of 6061 projects has been completed till now.

10. The current status of progress (cumulative) of the different components of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) is as follows:-

- i. Computerization of Land Records of 6,22,773 Villages completed.
- ii. Computerization of Registration 4,968 SROs completed.
- iii. Digitization of 1,30,72,020 Cadastral Maps/FMBs/Tippans completed.
- iv. Integration of 4,360 SROs with land records completed.
- v. Establishment of Modern Records Rooms in 3,327 Tehsils completed.
