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
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About the department

Salient Features



- 1. Restriction on the property is displayed at the applicant level (PTCL, Govt land & Court Injunction)
- 2. Dues on the property are displayed at the applicant level
- 3. Property details are fetched from the source (Bhoomi, e-Swathu & e-Asthi)
- 4. Valuation of property is done by the applicant
- 5. Citizen can withdraw their application at any time without penalty before the presentation of the document
- 6. Citizen can reschedule his appointment before the presentation, without any cost
- 7. All related documents are uploaded for verification
- 8. Scrutiny of documents is done within 24 hours and is before the presentation of the document
- 9. Scrutiny is completely digital
- 10. Multi-level verification for duties to be paid (FDA & SR)



Salient Features



- 11. High-value documents are sent to virtual auditors for duty verification (Concurrent Audit)
- 12. Stamp duty and the Registration fee are received before the presentation
- 13. Appointments get postponed automatically if the applicant fails to appear before the allocated time (grace period of 30 Min)
- 14. Digital endorsement is given, if there is a difference in uploaded and actual presented documents.
- 15. First in first out method for scrutiny and presentation of documents
- 16. Can be reverted to DEO for any mistake in photos and scanning
- 17. SR digitally signs every scanned document.
- 18. Process is completed only after the acknowledgement is generated
- 19. Same-day scanning is mandatory, otherwise, the next-day application will not work
- 20. Option for XML push (for mutation process)



Salient Features



- 21. Office hours are centrally managed
- 22. System user authentication is mandatory by biometrics of employee
- 23. Department application accessible only through KSWAN
- 24. Appointments get rescheduled for the same day if any technical issues.






Kaveri 2.0 Eco-system





Behavioural Change after Kaveri 2.0




- Staff are attending office on time (10 am to 6 pm)
- Maximum staff are using computers on their own
- Staff are having lunch at a specified time (1.30 pm to 2.30 pm)
- Applicants are coming to SRO on time (Buffer time 1hr)
- Overcrowding has reduced drastically in SRO
- Except for registration, most of the services are availed by the public directly without Agents.
- Pending documents have come down
