# Status of Urban Land Records


- In Tamil Nadu for survey of Urban Lands, a different methodology is used (compared with survey methodology used for Rural lands).
- > The Urban Land records are more accurate than the Rural Land records.
- > Each land parcel has been assigned a separate Town Survey Number (TS No).
- A Town consists of Wards within which Blocks are created and the blocks comprised of Town Survey Numbers (individual land parcels).
- ➤ All 21 corporations and 89 out of 140 Municipalities have been surveyed and land records have been created.

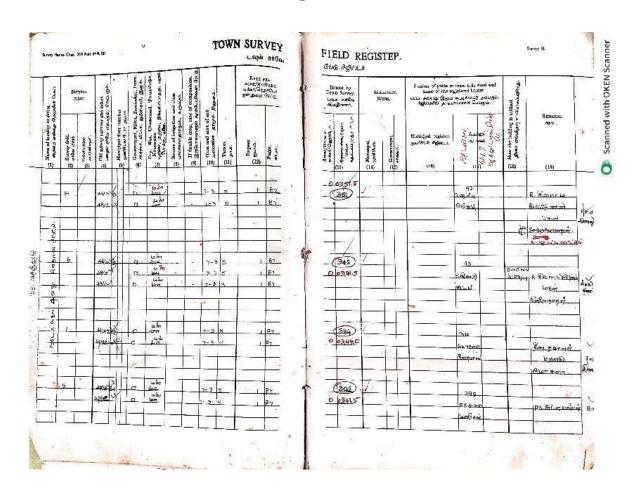

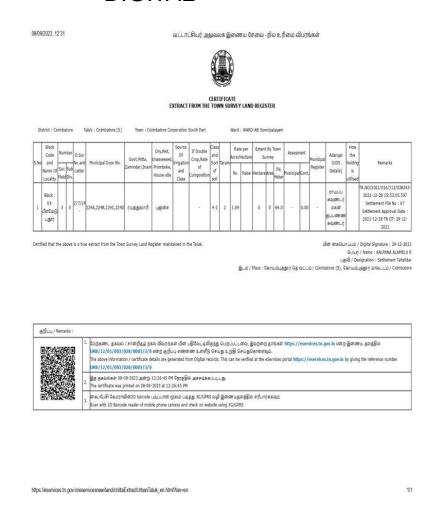
