- Resolution of the HRSI 40cm
- Satellite data provider NRSC, Hyderabad, ISRO from the year : 2017 18
- Per Sq. KM rate for Survey Resurvey operation approved from Rs. 10200 to 18000 per Sq. KM.
- Approved rate of GoI Rs. 25500 per Sq. KM.
- Total Milestones / Steps in the Survey work 12
- Guideline issued for Survey Resurvey work July, 2021
- Mode of Survey Operation Company Survey team + Revenue Staff
- Due to lack of staff in Settlement Department, revenue staff (Patwari, ILR, Tehsildar and SDO) have been

given powers for Settlement Operations

- Work order given for II-Phase Districts 2021-22


#### **Status of Survey – Resurvey Project in Rajasthan**

- Establishment of Ground Control Point (GCP) Network Completed for Phase – I and partially for Phase-II districts
- The draft land parcel map based on Satellite Imagery prepared for all the villages of Phase I districts
- Final record (New RoR and New Maps) Completed in 4 tehsils
- Survey work in operation at present 46 tehsils
- Expected date of completion of 46 tehsils July 2025
- Expected date of Completion of remaining tehsils of Phase-I districts –
   March, 2026
- Bid for procurement of HRSI for Phase II districts floated April, 2025
- Bid for procurement of 78 rovers for Revenue Officials under DILRMP incentive schemes floated – April, 2025






#### Process Flow of Survey Resurvey






#### **DEM & CONTOUR MAP OF UNIARA TEHSIL**






# FINAL VILLAGE BOUNDARY OF GUMANPURA VILLAGE




#### **Private Land Encroachment in entire Uniara tehsil**










# Mosaic: Seamless New Khasra Map of Entire Uniara Tehsil

#### **Development of a web portal for Survey-Resurvey work**

- Provision to electronically e-signing of all the forms to be signed by Patwari, Girdawar, Tehsildar and Sub-Division Officer.
- Electronically distribution of Parcha Notices to all Land-hodlers.
- Electronically inviting the objections from the Land-holders and their resolution.
- Display of new Survey Record on NIC Portals and facility for viewing and downloading of Revenue Records.
- Facility for uploading and storing High Resolution Satellite Imagery.
- The State NIC is developing this web portal.

#### **Salient Features: Survey – Resurvey Project in Rajasthan**

- High Resolution Satellite Imagery Used: 40 cm
- ■DEM of 1m and Contours of 1.2 m generated which are quite useful for engineering departments like Watershed, Water Resources etc.
- Guidelines issued for Survey staff
- Final record prepared keeping in view the ground reality and old RoR. The Old Cadastral Maps are used only for reference purposes.
- ■Due to lack of staff in Settlement Department, Tehsildar and SDO have been given powers for Settlement Operations. For Settlement operations, Tehsildar acts as Assistant Land Record Officer and SDO as Additional Land Record Officer.
- Quality control measures are in place for every activity.
- Public awareness camps are organized.
