I am directed to say that Rejuvenating Watersheds for Agricultural Resilience through Innovative Development (REWARD) is a Program for Results (P for R) program financed by the World Bank, Government of India, and State Governments. The program covers: (i) the Department of Land Resources (DOLR), Government of India (ii) Watershed Development Department (WDD), Government of Karnataka (GoK) and, (iii) Directorate of Soil Conservation and Watershed (DSC & WD), Government of Odisha (GoO).

- 2. Reward is a five-year program with Program Development Objective to Strengthen Capacities of National and State Institutions; to adopt improved watershed management for increasing farmers' resilience; and support value chains in watersheds of participating States.
