

Department of Land Resources (DoLR) has six Divisions which fundamentally discharge the following responsibilities:

1. Watershed Management Division is responsible for implementation of (a) Watershed Development component – Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY), (b) World Bank assisted – new multi-State Watershed Project namely “Rejuvenating Watershed for Agricultural Resilience through Innovative Development (REWARD), and (c) Inter-departmental and inter-disciplinary coordination in planning and implementation of the Watershed Development Programmes including Training, Climate Change and International Cooperation of Watershed Management etc.

2. Land Regulations Division is responsible for the administration of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013; the Registration Act, 1908; State specific Amendments under these Acts and related Land issues, implementation of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP), etc. The division is also responsible for Land Governance and Assessment Framework (LGAF), National Land Use Policy, National Land Reforms Policy, Land Use Planning, Land Leasing Laws, Land Reforms, Land Tenures etc.

3. Programme Monitoring and Evaluation Division is responsible for monitoring and evaluation of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) being implemented by the Department. The important activities of the Division are monitoring of impact assessment/evaluation of schemes of DILRMP, Land Acquisition Compensation Rehabilitation Resettlement Information System (LACRRIS) and Information, Education and Communication (IEC) activities etc.

4. Administration and Coordination Division Department of Land Resources, as part of its administrative responsibility, undertakes Establishment matters which include service issues, posting of officers and staff, capacity building, vigilance matters, etc. It also deals with implementation of official language, protocol, website and portal, procurement of goods and services, organization and methods and all other general administration matters.

The Co-ordination Division of the Department is responsible for managing issues relating to Parliament matters, RTI matters, e-Samiksha, PRAGATI, SGOS recommendations, Annual Report and other publications of Department, Media Campaign, and various other matters, which involve coordination with various Ministries/Department.

5. Integrated Finance Division of Ministry of Rural Development acts as a representative of Ministry of Finance to ensure financial discipline and adherence to financial procedures. It provides financial concurrence for release of funds from the Budget Allocation of the Department.

6. Budget Division is responsible for the finalization of Demands for Grants, Budget Estimates/Revised Estimates and Internal Audit, etc.
