Introduction

ENVIS is a decentralized system with a network of distributed state specific centres (working on status of Environment and related issues of a particular state/UT) and subject oriented centres ensuring integration of national efforts in environmental information collection, collation, storage, retrieval and dissemination to all concerned.

ENVIS Hub Haryana has started its functioning on October, 2019 at Environment & Climate Change Department, Haryana, Chandigarh.

Objectives

- The ENVIS serves as a single-stop web-enabled repository of comprehensive environmental information.
- The focus of ENVIS since inception has been on providing environmental information to decision makers, policy planners, scientists and engineers, research workers, etc. all over the country.

Functions

- The mandate of ENVIS scheme is to collect, collate and disseminate information relating to a variety of themes associated with MoEF&CC, namely, Environment, Forest, Wildlife and Climate Change sectors.
- ENVIS Hubs are required to collect data from the state & districts departments/bodies and periodically update and maintain the India State-level Basic Environmental Information Database (ISBEID), a web-enabled application developed by the EI Division in collaboration with NIC.



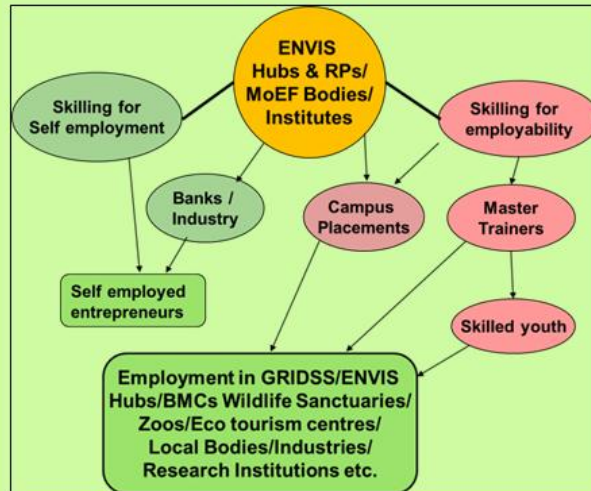

Major Initiatives of ENVIS

i. Green Skill Development Programme (GSDP) –

- The Ministry has taken up an initiative to fill up the skill gaps by imparting training to skill the youth in environment, forest and wildlife sectors and enabling them to be gainfully employed or self-employed.



- The Programme endeavors to develop a green skilled workforce, having technical knowledge and commitment to sustainable development, which will help in the attainment of the Intended Nationally Determined Contributions (INDCs),

Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and National Biodiversity Targets (NBTs).

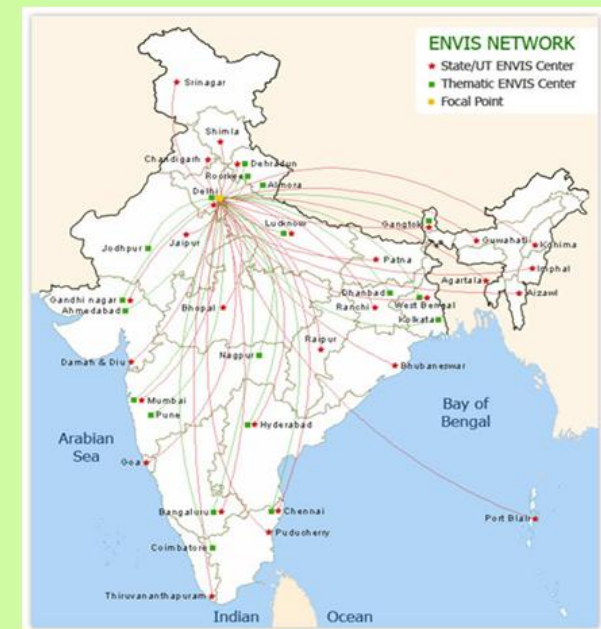
- The Programme offered a Basic Course and an Advanced Course to skill the youth. 10 courses have been shortlisted and will be organized at Hissar Agriculture University (CCSHAU).

ii. National Environment Survey (NES) –

- It is a Grid-based Resource Information and Decision Support System (GRIDSS) for sustainable management of natural resources.
- The Survey would cover various parameters like flora, fauna, pollution, waste inventory mapping, etc., to fill data gaps in respect of various environmental parameters and to ascertain the status of environment at district level.
- It will help in developing a robust decision support system (DSS), which will help environmental planning and policy.
- The Karnal District has been shortlisted for the NES in the first phase of the Programme.

Nation wide Network of ENVIS

ENVIS network at presently consists of a chain of 68 ENVI centres out of which 40 are on subject specific and 28 on State/UT related issues. The Focal Point of ENVIS is located in the ministry and assists by EI Divisions in coordinating the activities of all the ENVIS network partners.
