- 3. **Cost of Bid Form**: As mentioned in column number 12 (non-refundable).
- 4. Availability of Bid Document and mode of submission: The bid document is available online and bid should be submitted online on website www.pmgsytendersuk.gov.in The bidder would be required to register in the website which is free of cost. For submission of bids, the bidder is required to have valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) from one of the authorized Certifying Authorities (CA). "Aspiring bidders who have not obtained the user ID and password for participating in e- tendering in PMGSY may obtain the same from the website: www. pmgsytenders.gov.in."

The technical qualification part of the bids will be opened online on 18-07-2025 03:00 PM by the authorized officers. If the office happens to be closed on the date of opening of the bids as specified, the bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time.
- 9. The bidder is not required to quote his rate for routine maintenance. The rates to be paid for routine maintenance are indicated in the Bill of Quantities. Further, the payment for routine maintenance to the contractor shall be regulated based on his performance of maintenance activities for the works. Maintenance for the works will be carried out through Performance Based Maintenance Contracting (PBMC).

15. SRRDA/Employer reserves all the rights in reference to the SBD Section-2 ITB para-4.7, bidders are subject to be disqualified if they have:

- (i) made misleading or false representations in the forms, statements, affidavits and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements; and/or
- (ii) record of poor performance such as abandoning the works, not properly completing the contract, inordinate delays in completion, litigation history or financial failures etc.
- (iii) participated in the previous bidding for the same work and had quoted unreasonably high or low bid prices and could not furnish rational justification for it to the Employer.

- 17. Experience of Similar Nature Work as required in SBD Section-2 (ITB) Clause-4.2(c) & 4.4A(b) will only be considered for the works completed before the publication date of NIT.
- 18. In Stage-I&II works, experience of single similar nature prime work of Stage-I&II is required as per SBD Section-2 (ITB) Clause-4.2(c) & 4.4A(b). However, if the experience of Stage-II prime work is given, additional seperate experience of Stage-I work will also be required.
- 19. Upgradation works which have been sanctioned under PMGSY-III in Innovative Technology i.e. Waste Plastic, Cell-Filled Concrete, Cold Mix etc., an affidavit to be submitted by the participating bidder that he will use the new technology material as per provisions made in BoQ and also provide the machines and other arrangements required for completion of work. Bidders are also required to follow the directions given by the technology provider and will have to sign the tripartite agreement.

- 21. For each PMGSY III work, an affidavit must be submitted by the participating bidders, stating that they will install the Vehicle Tracking System (VTS) (GPS) provided by the URRDA/PIU vendor on all their equipment (as per the bid data sheet) throughout the construction of the work.
