FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

To Assist Candidates

Q. No. 1: How to use registration and Choice filling form on website?

Ans: Candidates will have to log on to website https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in to get registered and then fill in choices. Please study Chhattisgarh AYUSH UG Admission Rules 2023 published on counseling website and Information Bulletin carefully. It is advised that after going through the list of seats available, a tentative list may be prepared first as per your preference of colleges, before attempting to fill choices on-line.

Q. No. 2: Do I require any documents to get registered online?

Ans: No. however information based on NTA application needs to be filled in relevant fields.

IMPORTANT

Keep the information confidential, and do not share the password and OTP with anybody. Keep print out of application form ready for reference with you.

Q. No. 3: What information do I require for online registration?

Ans: Please note that you will be asked to fill some of the information that you have given on your application form during online registration for participating in NEET UG, therefore, keep copy of your application form of NEET UG for reference.

IMPORTANT

Please note that on registration window of online allotment process, you have to fill in exactly same spelling, numbers etc. as you have filled in your application form.

Q. No. 4: Is there Separate Registration for BAMS/BHMS and BNYS Course?

Ans: **Yes,** There will be one registration for BAMS/BHMS Courses and there will be separate registration for BNYS Course.

Q. No. 5: How and when I have to make registration payment?

Ans: After registering for fresh registration, payment page appears automatically. Candidate may pay online by Net Banking / credit card/ debit card/ UPI/ Wallet. Only after the successful payment candidate will be allowed to proceed for choice filling.

For State Quota seats: Unreserved/OBC – Rs. 1500/- & ST/SC/EWS – Rs. 900/-.

For All India Quota seats (State & other State Candidates)- Rs. 1500/-.

Q. No. 6: Is there any restriction for filling up number of choices of Institution (College) and courses (i.e. BAMS/BHMS and BNYS) in choice fillingform? Ans: No, you can give as many choices as you wish during online choice filling. However, choices should be in order of candidate's preference.

Q.No. 7 Is it necessary to fill up the choices and lock the choices to get seat allotted? Or it will be allotted seat automatically from leftover seats?

Ans: After online registration (registration is compulsory to take part in online allotment process, before the round -1 during specified registration period), you have to fill in choice of Institutions/colleges/courses in order of your preference. Once choice is filled in, it can be modified before locking it. During the choice locking period, it is necessary to lock the choices to get a print of your submitted choices. If candidate does not lock the choice submitted by him/her, it will be automatically locked as per last entry made by candidate.

Registration will be done once before Round-1. If required, fresh registration will be done for Stray vacancy round.

IMPORTANT:

Don't wait till the last minute to Register and Lock your choices and to take a printout. Please go through your submitted choices before locking, as once you lock the choices they can be modified or changed by unlocking choices upto stipulated time. After locking time, choices once locked can not be modified.

Q. No. 8: Is it necessary to join allotted AYUSH College of Round 1 to get chance to participate in Round 2?

Ans: Candidates have to take admission if they are allotted Govt. College, otherwise they will not be eligible for next rounds of counseling. After joining, Candidates may give their willingness for upgradation in Round-2. Candidates who have been allotted private college, they can opt free exit. But they have to get their documents scrutinized and verified.

However, if they want to retain the Round 1 seat and upgrade in round 2 they have to physically join the college of Round 1 and will give up-gradation willingness for Round 2.

Q. No. 9: If a candidate does not report at the allotted college during Round 2 whether he has to register again for Mop Up round?

Ans:- No fresh registration is required for MOP up round. If a candidate does not report at allotted college during Round 2 then he will be debarred from MOP Up round. It is mandatory to secure admission on allotted seat in Round-2.

Q. No. 10: Who are eligible for 2nd Round of allotment?

Ans: Candidates eligible for seat allotment in 2nd round would be from one of the following groups:

Group–I: Registered candidates who did not get any seat allotment in the 1st round Group–II: Candidates who have reported at allotted institute during 1st round of allotment and submitted willingness for upgradation in Round-1.

Q. No. 11: Can a candidate participate in second round without submitting fresh choices (based on choices submitted before round-1)?

Ans: For second round of counseling candidate will have to select his choices from available seats of available institutes as displayed on the website.

Q. No. 12: If I forget my password that I have created during the process of registration, how to retrieve it?

Ans: To retrieve the forgotten password, system facilitates the following process: The candidate is required to enter the information that he/she filled at the time of registration and then security question & answer thereon to be entered as given during New Candidate registration process. The above data submitted by candidate will be validated with the registered candidate's database. If the above entries match, then only the candidate would be permitted to enter new password to proceed further.

Q. No. 13: In case I get an upgraded seat but in the same college, because of change of category, (e.g. from SC or ST to UR category) do I have to take admission on the allotted seat again?

Ans: Yes, you have to get a relieving letter generated on-line for the earlier seat and then get an admission letter again generated on-line for the upgraded category seat from the concerned institution; otherwise your seat will be cancelled and allotted to another candidate.

Q.No. 14:- What is the procedure for Mop Up Round Counseling?

Ans. The net vacant seats due to non joining, non reporting of Round 2 will be published in the seat matrix and eligible candidates have to submit fresh choices and the result will be processed as per Choice & Merit.

Q. No. 15:- Whether Up-gradation is allowed from 2nd round counseling of State Quota seats to Mop-up Round counseling of AYUSH-UG Courses.

Ans. Yes, Up-gradation is allowed for candidate who joins on a seat allotted in Round-2 Counseling.

Q. No. 16: Who is Eligible for the Stray Vacancy Round.

Ans. Following Registered Candidates are eligible for stray vacancy round:-

- a) Candidates who are not allotted any seat upto MOP up round.
- b) Candidates allotted a seat in any round of counseling (upto MOP up round) but did not joined the institute.
- a) Candidate found ineligible during document verification earlier.
- b) Candidates allotted a seat in any Round of counselling but neither Reported for Document Verification nor secured admission.

Q. No. 17: Who are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round of State Quota seats of Chhattisgarh?

ANS: Following Candidates are not eligible:-

- a) Candidates who did not registered themselves for counseling scheme.
- b) Candidates who are allotted a seat in any round of counseling (upto MOP up round) and join the institute.
- c) Candidate joined/holding a seat in AIQ by AACCC (Ayush Admissions Central Counselling Committee)

Q.No. 18: Will there be any Fresh Registration/choice filling for Stray Vacancy Round?

Ans. Yes, there will be Fresh Registration/choice filling for the Stray vacancy Round. Candidates registered themselves earlier before Round-1 need not to register again, they will only give consent to participate in Stray Vacancy Round and will give fresh choices as per available seat matrix.

Q.No. 19: How much time will be given to join the allotted college?

ANS: As per schedule made available at the time of result announcement.

R. No. 20: Is It mandatory to verify document after seat allotment in any round If I do not want to get admission?

Ans: Yes, It is mandatory to verify your documents after seat allotment in any round of counselling. If you do not want to join the allotted institute or want free exit, document verification will be mandatory. Without document verification candidate will be debarred from further counselling process.

Q. No. 21: What documents are required at the time of Joining/ Reporting in allotted AYUSH College?

Ans: Original documents (along with two set of attested photocopies of documents) for admission to under- graduate AYUSH courses in allotted college are as mentioned below.

- I. Admit Cards of Exam issued by NEET (except for BNYS).
- II. Result/ Rank letter issued by NEET (except for BNYS).
- III. Class 10th Marksheet
- IV. Class 10+2 Marksheet
- v. Allotment Letter issued by AYUSH, CG
- VI. Eight (8) Passport size photograph same as affixed on the NEET application form.
- VII. Proof of identity (Aadhar/ PAN/ Driving License/ Passport/ Voter ID)
- VIII. Domicile certificate
- IX. Caste certificate
- x. EWS Certificate
- XI. Disability Certificate
- XII. Minority Certificate

- XIII. Gap certificate
- XIV. Transfer Certificate
- xv. Character Certificate
- xvi. Migration Certificate
- XVII. Medical Fitness Certificate.
