NEET UG (AYUSH) Course Admission Year 2025 FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

To Assist Candidates

Q.No.1: How to use registration and Choice filling form on website?

Ans: Candidates will have to login on website https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in to get registered and then fill in choices after fee payment. Please study Chhattisgarh AYUSH UG Admission Rules 2023 and Information Bulletin carefully published on counseling website. It is advised that after going through the list of available seats, a tentative list may be prepared as per your preference of colleges, before attempting to choice filling.

Q.No.2: Do I require any documents to get registered online?

Ans: No, however information based on NTA application needs to be filled in relevant fields.

IMPORTANT

Keep the information confidential, and do not share the password and OTP with anybody. Keep print out of application form ready for reference with you.

Q.No.3: What information do I require for online registration for BAMS/BHMS course?

Ans: Please note that you will be asked to fill some of the information that you have given in your application form during online registration for participating in NEET UG, therefore, keep copy of your application form and admit card of NEET UG for reference.

IMPORTANT:

Please note that on registration window of online allotment process, you have to fill in exactly same spelling, numbers etc. as you have filled in your application form.

Q. No.4: Is there separate Registration for BAMS/BHMS and BNYS Course?

Ans: Yes, There will be one registration for BAMS & BHMS Courses and a Page 1 of 6

separate registration for BNYS Course.

Q. No.5: How and when I have to make registration payment?

Ans: After registering for fresh registration, payment page appears automatically. Candidate has to pay online by Net Banking/credit card/debit card/UPI/Wallet. Only after the successful payment candidate will be allowed to proceed for choice filling.

For State Quota seats: Unreserved/OBC – Rs. 1500/- & ST/SC/EWS – Rs. 900/-. For All India Quota seats (State & other State Candidates)- Rs. 1500/-.

Q.No.6: If I forget my password that I have created during the process of registration, how to retrieve it?

Ans: To retrieve the forgotten password, system facilitates the following process: The candidate is required to enter the information that he/she filled at the time of registration and then security question & answer thereon to be entered as given during New Candidate registration process. The above data submitted by candidate will be validated with the registered candidate's data base. If the above entries match, then only the candidate would be permitted to enter new password to proceed further.

Q.No.7: Is there separate registration for State Quota seats and All India Quota Seats?

Ans: No, a single registration will be done for Sate Quota seats as well as All India Quota seats. Candidates can opt either of them or both options as per their eligibility.

Q.No.8: Is there any restriction for filling up number of choices of Institution (College) and courses (i.e. BAMS/ BHMS and BNYS) in choice filling form?

Ans: No, you can give as many as choices you wish during online choice filling. However, choices should be in order of candidate's preference. Be careful before filling choices as it is mandatory to take admission after seat allotment otherwise you will be debarred from rest of the counseling process.

Q.No.9: Is it necessary to fill up the choices and lock the choices to get seat allotted? Or the seat will be allotted automatically from leftover seats?

Ans: After online registration (registration is compulsory to take part in online allotment process, before the round -1 during specified registration period), candidate have to fill in choice of Institutions/colleges/courses in order of your preference. Once choice is filled in, it can be modified before locking it. During the choice locking period, it is necessary to lock the choices to get a print of your submitted choices. If candidate does not lock the choices submitted, it will be automatically locked as per last entry made by candidate. Candidate has to fill the choices to participate in allotment process. Without choices he will be excluded from seat allotment.

Registration will be done once before Round-1. If required, fresh registration will be done for Stray vacancy round.

IMPORTANT:

Don't wait till the last minute to Register and Lock your choices and to take a printout. Please go through your submitted choices before locking, as once you lock the choices they can be modified or changed by unlocking choices upto stipulated time. After last date choices cannot be modified.

Q.No.10: Is it necessary to join allotted AYUSH College of Round 1 to get chance to participate in Round2?

Ans: Candidates have to take admission if they have been allotted any College, otherwise they will not be eligible for next rounds of counseling. After admission, Candidates may give their willingness for upgradation in Round-2.

Q.No.11: If a candidate does not take admission after seat allotment during Round 2 whether he has to register again for Mop Up round?

Ans: No fresh registration is there for MOP Up round. If a candidate does not report Page 3 of 6

at allotted college during Round 2 then he will be debarred from counseling process. It is mandatory to secure admission on allotted seat.

Q. No.12: Who are eligible for 2nd Round of allotment?

Ans: Candidates eligible for seat allotment in 2nd round would be from one of the following groups:

- a) Candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Round-1.
- b) Who have filled choices for Round-2.
- c) Those submitted willingness for upgradation in Round-1 are eligible for Round-2.

Q.No.13: If any registered candidate does not fill choices in Round-1, can he participate in Round-2?

Ans: yes, he can participate by filling choices in Round-2.

Q.No.14: Can a candidate participate in second round without submitting fresh choices (based on choices submitted before round-1)?

Ans: For second round of counseling candidate will have to select his choices from available seats of available Institutes as displayed on the website.

Q. No. 15: In case I get an upgraded seat but in the same college, because of change of category, (e.g. from SC or ST to UR category) do I have to take admission on the allotted seat again?

Ans: No, There will be no upgradation in the same college.

Q.No.16:-What is the procedure for Mop Up Round Counseling?

Ans: The net vacant seats due to non-joining, non-reporting of Round 2 will be published in the seat matrix and eligible candidates have to submit fresh choices and the result will be processed as per Choice & Merit.

Q.No.17:- Whether Up-gradation is allowed from 2nd round counseling of State Quota seats to Mop-up Round counseling of AYUSH UG Courses.

Ans: Yes, Upgradation is allowed for candidate who takes admission on allotted seat in Round-2 Counseling.

Q.No.18: Who is Eligible for the Stray Vacancy Round?

Ans: Following Registered Candidates are eligible for stray vacancy round:-

- a) Pre-Registered candidates who have not been allotted any seat up to MOP up round.
- b) Fresh registered candidates in stray vacancy round.

Q.No.19: Who are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round of State Quota seats of Chhattisgarh?

Ans: Following Candidates are not eligible:-

- a) Candidates who did not registered themselves for counseling process.
- b) Candidates who are allotted any seat in any round of counseling (upto MOP up round).
- c) Candidate joined/holding a seat in AIQ by AACCC (Ayush Admissions Central Counselling Committee)

Q.No.20: Will there be any Fresh Registration/choice filling for Stray Vacancy Round?

Ans: Yes, there will be Fresh Registration/choice filling for the Stray vacancy Round. Candidates registered themselves earlier before Round-1 and did not get any seat in any round need not to register again, they will have to fill choices in Stray Vacancy Round.

Q.No.21: How much time will be given to join the allotted college?

Ans: As per schedule made available at the time of result announcement.

Q.No.22: Is it mandatory to verify document after seat allotment in any round if I do not want to get admission?

Ans: No, It is not mandatory to verify your documents after seat allotment in any round of counseling if you do not want to join the allotted institute.

Q.No.23: What documents are required at the time of Joining/Reporting in allotted AYUSH College?

Ans: Original documents (along with two set of attested photocopies of documents) for admission to under-graduate AYUSH courses in allotted college are as mentioned below.

- I. Admit Cards of Exam issued by NEET (except for BNYS).
- II. Result/Rank letter issued by NEET (except for BNYS).
- III. Class 10th Marksheet
- IV. Class 10+2 Marksheet
- v. Allotment Letter issued by AYUSH, CG
- VI. Eight (8) Passport size photograph same as affixed on the NEET application form.
- VII. Proof of identity (Aadhar/PAN/Driving License/Passport/ Voter ID)
- VIII. Domicile certificate
- IX. Caste certificate
- x. EWS Certificate
- XI. Disability Certificate
- XII. Minority Certificate
- XIII. Gap certificate
- XIV. Transfer Certificate
- xv. Character Certificate
- XVI. Migration Certificate
- XVII. Medical Fitness Certificate.
