#### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ'S)

#### **To Assist Candidates**

### Q.No.1: How to use registration and Choice filling form on website?

Ans: Candidates will have to log in to website <a href="https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in">https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in</a> to get registered and then fill in choices. Please study Chhattisgarh AYUSH PG Admission Rules 2024 and Information Bulletin carefully published on counseling website. It is advised that after going through the list of seats available, a tentative list may be prepared as per your preference of colleges, before attempting to choice filling.

#### Q.No.2: Do I require any documents to get registered online?

Ans: No. however information based on NTA application needs to be filled in relevant fields.

#### **IMPORTANT**

Keep the information confidential, and do not share the password and OTP with anybody. Keep print out of application form ready for reference with you.

### Q.No.3: What information do I require for online registration?

Ans: Please note that you will be asked to fill some of the information that you have given in your application form during online registration for participating in AIAPGET 2025, therefore, keep copy of your application form of AIAPGET for reference.

#### **IMPORTANT**

Please note that during registration window of online allotment process, you have to fill in exactly same spelling, numbers etc. as you have filled in your application form.

#### Q. No.4: How and when I have to make registration payment?

**Ans:** After registering for fresh registration, payment page appears automatically. Candidate may pay online by Net Banking/credit card/debit card/UPI/Wallet. Only after the successful payment candidate will be allowed to proceed for choice filling.

### Q. No.5: What are the various fees to be paid at the time of registration?

Ans: At the time of registration, candidate must pay two kinds of fee:-

#### a) Registration Fee (Non-Refundable)

Category of the candidate	Amount
For State Quota seats: Unreserved/OBC	Rs.2000/-
For State Quota seats: ST/SC/EWS	Rs.1500/-
For All India Quota seats & Jain Minority	Rs.2000/-

b) Security money (Refundable conditionally) will be refunded to candidates as per the counseling rules to the bank account from which payment of counseling fees has been made. The candidates are advised to keep their bank account active till the refund process is completed.

Category of the candidate	Security Amount
All Categories	Rs.10,000/-

### Q.No.6: Is Security deposit refundable in all the cases?

Ans: Candidate willing to participate in counseling process has to deposit security amount of Rs. 10,000/- at the time of registration. If candidate take admission on allotted seat in any round of counseling or candidates who have not been allotted any seat will get complete refund of security deposit. If any candidate does not take admission on allotted seat or cancel his admission after allotment, in both conditions security deposit will be forfeited.

### Q.No.7: Is there any restriction for filling up number of choices of Institution and subjects in choice filling form?

Ans: No, you can give as many as choices you wish during online choice filling. However, choices should be in order of candidate's preference.

### Q.No.8: Is it necessary to fill up the choices and lock the choices to get seat allotted? Or the seat will be allotted automatically from leftover seats?

Ans: After online registration (registration is compulsory to take part in online allotment process, before the Round -1 during specified registration period), you have to fill in choice of Institutions/subjects in order of your preference. Once choice is filled in, it can be modified before locking it. During the choice locking period, it is necessary to lock the choices to get a print of your submitted choices. If candidate does not lock the choice submitted by him/her, it will be automatically locked as per last entry made by candidate. Candidates have to fill choices to get a seat.

#### IMPORTANT:

Don't wait till the last minute to Register and Lock your choices and to take a printout. Please go through your submitted choices before locking, as once you lock the choices they can be modified or changed by unlocking choices upto stipulated time. After locking time, choices once locked cannot be modified.

### Q.No.9: Is it necessary to join allotted AYUSH College of Round-1 to get chance to participate in Round-2?

Ans: It is mandatory to take admission if he has been allotted seat in Govt. College, otherwise they will be ineligible for next rounds of counseling. After joining, Candidates may give their willingness for upgradation in Round-2. Candidates who have been allotted private college, they can opt free exit in Round 1 only.

However, if they want to retain the Round-1 seat and upgrade in Round-2, they have to physically join the college of Round-1 and will give upgradation willingness for Round-2.

### Q.No.10: If a candidate does not report at the allotted college during Round-2 whether he has to register again for Mop-Up round?

Ans:- No fresh registration is there for MOP-Up round. If a candidate does not report at allotted college during Round-2 then he will be debarred from MOP-Up round. It is mandatory to secure admission on allotted seat in Round-2.

### Q. No.11: Who are eligible for 2<sup>nd</sup> Round of allotment?

Ans: Candidates eligible for seat allotment in Round-2 would be from one of the following groups:

- a) Registered candidates who did not get any seat allotment in the Round-1.
- b) Candidates who have taken admission in allotted institute and submitted willingness for upgradation in Round-1.
- c) Candidates who opted free exit after seat allotment in private institute in Round 1.
- d) Candidates who did not fill choices in Round-1.

# Q.No.12: Can a candidate participate in second round without submitting fresh choices (based on choices submitted before round-1)?

Ans: For second round of counseling, candidate will have to select his choices from available seats of available institutes as displayed on the website. In cases of upgradation, if candidate does not fill choices in Round-2 then he will retain the previously allotted seat.

# Q.No.13: If I forget my password that I have created during the process of registration, how to retrieve it?

Ans: To retrieve the forgotten password, system facilitates the following process: The candidate is required to enter the information that he/she filled at the time of registration and then security question & answer thereon to be entered as given during New Candidate registration process. The above data submitted by candidate Page 4 of 7

will be validated with the registered candidate's data base. If the above entries match, then only the candidate would be permitted to enter new password to proceed further.

# Q. No. 14: In case I get an upgraded seat but in the same college, because of change of category, (e.g. from SC or ST to UR category) do I have to take admission on the allotted seat again?

Ans: There will be no upgradation in the same college and same subject. Candidate can upgrade in same college but at different subject and the candidate does not have to take admission again.

#### Q.No.15:-What is the procedure for Mop Up Round Counseling?

Ans. The net vacant seats due to non-joining, non-reporting of Round 2 will be published in the seat matrix and eligible candidates have to submit fresh choices and the result will be processed as per Choice & Merit.

# Q. No. 16:- Whether Up-gradation is allowed from 2<sup>nd</sup> round counseling of State Quota seats to Mop-up Round counseling of AYUSH UG Courses.

Ans. Yes, Upgradation is allowed for candidate who joins on a seat allotted in Round-2 Counseling and opt upgradation.

### Q. No. 17: Who is Eligible for the Stray Vacancy Round?

Ans. Following Registered Candidates are eligible for stray vacancy round:-

- a) Candidates who did fresh registration for stray vacancy round.
- b) Candidates who are not allotted any seat upto MOP up round.

### No.18: Who are not eligible for Stray Vacancy Round?

Ans: Following Candidates are not eligible:-

- a) Candidates who did not registered themselves for counseling scheme.
- b) Candidates who are being allotted a seat in any round of counseling (upto MOP up round).
- c) Candidate joined/holding a seat in AIQ counseling by AACCC (Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee)

### Q.No. 19: Will there be any Fresh Registration/choice filling for Stray Vacancy Round?

Ans. Yes, there will be Fresh Registration/choice filling for the Stray vacancy Round. Candidates registered themselves earlier before Round-1 and did not get any seat, need not to register again, they will have to only fill fresh choices as per available seat matrix.

### Q.No. 20: How much time will be given to join the allotted college?

Ans: As per schedule made available at the time of result announcement.

# Q. No.21: Is it mandatory to verify document after seat allotment in any round if I do not want to get admission?

Ans: No, It is not mandatory to verify your documents after seat allotment in any round of counseling, If you do not want to join the allotted institute or want free exit, document verification is not mandatory.

# Q.No.22: What documents are required at the time of Joining/Reporting at allotted College?

**Ans:** Original documents (along with two set of attested photocopies of documents) for admission to postgraduate AYUSH courses in allotted college are as mentioned below:-

- I. Admit Card of AIAPGET 2025.
- II. Result/Rank letter from AIAPGET 2025.
- III. Class 10<sup>th</sup> Marksheet
- IV. Class 10+2 Marksheet
- v. Marksheets of all examinations of BAMS
- VI. Internship completion certificate
- VII. BAMS Degree certificate
- VIII. Central or State Registration certificate (permanent) from any Authorize Ayurved Board/ Council.
- IX. Allotment Letter issued by AYUSH, CG
- x. Eight (8) Passport size photograph same as affixed on the NEET application form.
- XI. Proof of identity (Aadhar/PAN/Driving License/Passport/ Voter ID)
- XII. Domicile certificate
- XIII. Caste certificate (if required)
- XIV. Income Certificate (if required)
- xv. EWS Certificate (if required)
- XVI. Minority Certificate (if required)
- XVII. Gap certificate (if required)
- XVIII. Transfer Certificate
- XIX. Character Certificate
- xx. Migration Certificate
- XXI. Medical Fitness Certificate.
