DIRECTORATE OF AYUSH, CHHATTISGARH**

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Qualified and eligible candidates are required to register on the Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh website i.e. <https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in> to participate in the online counseling process. Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh does not allot any seat either manually or on nomination basis.
2. Candidates are requested to read rules and regulations (Chhattisgarh AYUSH UG Admission rule 2023) uploaded on counseling website before going through registration and counseling Scheme.
3. Candidates are deemed to have read, agreed and accepted the terms and conditions of the Counseling scheme for AYUSH-UG on completing the online submission of application/registration form.
4. Candidates are advised to use the same Mobile number/E-mail ID submitted during registration for NEET (UG)-2026 examination.
5. Candidates are advised to use Laptop or Computer along with the latest registered version of Chrome/Internet Explorer/Firefox/Windows/IOS during the Registration and Choice-Filling process to avoid any technical complications.
6. Candidates are advised to download SANDES app for OTP on their registered mobile number for registration. This might be useful for places where the network of registered mobile number is either not available or poor thus rendering the delivery of text messages difficult.
7. Candidates are advised to be in touch with the Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh counseling website (<https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in>) for Schedule /Seat Allotment/ Results / Latest updates and Notices pertaining to Counseling as Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh will not be individually contacting the candidates for the same.

8. Court cases w.r.t. Counseling must be in the Hon'ble High Court of Chhattisgarh, Bilaspur jurisdictions area only.
9. 15% AIQ Seats of Govt. Ayurved Colleges will be filled by AACCC (Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee), Ministry of AYUSH through separate counseling. Candidates are advised to be aware regarding the same. Counseling for 15% All India Quota seats of private Institutes will be done by the Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh along with 85% Chhattisgarh State Quota Seats of all Institutes. All AIQ Seats of private Institutes are open in nature (all category candidates are eligible), also these seats are domicile free. All the State Quota seats of Minority Institutions are domicile free. 50% of State Quota seats of Minority Institutions are reservation free (Unreserved) and rest 50% seats are reserved for Jain minority candidates.
10. Candidates are advised to confirm the fee structure/ any other additional fees from the colleges. The information regarding fee structure/stipend/bond amount/hostel/food/other conditions has been provided by concerned Colleges. Hence, Candidates are advised to visit the College website or contact the College Authorities directly for any query regarding the above information before filling choices.

11. Eligibility Criteria

a) For BAMS/BHMS

- i) Candidates must pass 12th (10+2) examination with physics, chemistry, biology or biotechnology and English subjects.
- ii) Candidates must qualify NEET (UG) – 2026 with minimum following percentile:

b) For BNYS

Candidates must pass 12th (10+2) examination with physics, chemistry, biology and English subjects. Candidate must have secured following aggregate marks in physics, chemistry and biology subjects.

12.Registration/Application

- a) Application for AYUSH-UG Counseling can only be submitted online through Directorate of AYUSH, CG counseling website <https://cgayush.admissions.nic.in> Application submitted through any other mode shall not be entertained. There shall be separate registration for BAMS/BHMS and BNYS Courses.
- b) Candidates are further advised to fill the application form on their own, not through any agent or third party.
- c) A candidate can submit online application/registration form only once. Any candidate found to have submitted more than one application/registration form for AYUSH-UG Counseling shall be debarred from AYUSH-UG Counseling allotment process and his candidature shall be cancelled and further action as deemed appropriate shall be taken by the Directorate of AYUSH, CG or CG Govt.
- d) Candidates may kindly note that registering for AYUSH-UG Counseling does not confer any automatic rights to secure an Undergraduate seat. The selection and admission to Undergraduate seats in a CG AYUSH Institution recognized for running Undergraduate courses as per NCISM Act & NCH

Act is subject to fulfilling the merit, admission criteria, eligibility, and such criteria as may be prescribed by CG AYUSH Institutions, Central Government and State Government.

- e) Candidates should ensure that all the information filled during the online application/registration is correct and factual. Information provided by the candidates in the online application/registration form shall be treated as correct and self-certified and Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh shall not entertain any request for change in the information provided by the candidates under any circumstances.
- f) Directorate of AYUSH, Chhattisgarh does not change/ edit /modify/alter any information (name, DOB, category, nationality, contact details etc.) entered by the candidates at the time of online submission of application/registration form for Counseling under any circumstances. The data entered by the candidate at the time of registration will be pre-populated and will be used for Counseling purposes. The Admission Authority will cancel the admission of those candidates who had provided wrong information during registration and fail to produce the required documents at the time of admission.
- g) Candidates are advised to confirm their eligibility/domicile status before registration for State Quota seats and All India Quota Seats of private Colleges.
- h) During online registration, candidates have to create a unique password. Candidates are advised to keep the password confidential till the end of the counseling process. The candidate can change the password as per convenience. Sharing of password can result in misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of genuine candidates from the online allotment process.
- i) There will be one separate registration for BAMS & BHMS courses (State

quota and AIQ Seats of Private Institute both). There will be a separate registration for BNYS course (State Quota). Candidate must register themselves carefully according to their desirable courses. Candidates can choose State quota or AIQ seats of private Institute or both during registration as per their eligibility and choices.

- j) Registration/Application fee (Non Refundable) will be paid once till Mop-up round. If seats remain vacant, a fresh registration will be done for Stray vacancy Round along with payment of Registration/Application fee. Registered candidates, who have not been allotted any seat up to Mop up round, need not to register again in Stray vacancy round and they will have to fill choices only.

13. Counseling: Online Counseling will be conducted in following four rounds

- Round 1
- Round 2
- Mop-Up round
- Stray Vacancy Round (if needed)

ROUND-1

Eligibility: All eligible and registered candidates can participate in Round-1.

Process of Round-1

- a) **Exercising of Choices and Locking of choices.**

After online registration, candidates must fill the choices of colleges/courses in order of their preference (higher to lower) and lock it before the server time. The submitted/ filled choices can be modified by unlocking choices till stipulated time. If candidates do not lock the choices submitted by them, it will be automatically locked as per schedule/ Server time. Candidates will not be allotted any seats if they don't fill their choices even after online registration. **Candidate must be sure before filling choices as once you fill choices then**

seat allotment will be done as per availability and then if candidate do not take admission then he will be debarred from rest of the counseling process. Candidates can download/print out the locked choices for future reference.

b) Process of Seat Allotment in Round-1

Seat allotment will be done on the basis of merit, choice filling & availability of seats.

- Candidates are advised to download seat allotment letter before document verification and physical reporting at verification Institute.
- Before downloading seat allotment letter, it is mandatory for every candidate to give his willingness online on counseling website, whether he wants to take admission in allotted institute or after taking admission wants to go for upgradation in next round. Once, the willingness is given it will not be change again, so be careful while opting willingness.
- In Round-1, it is mandatory to take admission in both Govt. and Private Institutions after seat allotment. After admission candidate can apply for upgradation in next rounds (Round-2 & Mop-Up Round). But if he/she does not take admission then he/she will be debarred from counseling process.
- Candidates who have been allotted a seat in Round-1 can opt for willingness to upgrade in Round-2 or Mop-Up Round. If any candidate opted upgradation in any round of counseling but did not fill choice then his earlier allotted seat will be retained.
- All admissions and withdrawals (if allowed) will be made through online mode only; no offline withdrawal of seat is permitted. Candidates must download the allotment letter from the Director of AYUSH, CG counseling website only.

c) Publication of result of Round- 1

d) **Document verification/Scrutiny**

- Document verification will be done by scrutiny committee at Scheduled time & place (as mentioned in allotment letter).
- Candidates must check the list of essential documents required (original documents) on counseling website before going for document verification and physical reporting at allotted institutes.
- All the documents regarding category (Caste certificate), EWS certificate, Class (PwD, Sainik, Freedom Fighter), Documents for verifying OBC Non creamy layer status, Domicile, Class 12th mark sheet and other documents ascertaining the eligibility of the candidate must be dated before last date of the registration.
- Certificate ascertaining the disability of the candidate and eligibility for seats under PwD quota must essentially be made by State Divisional/District Medical board only. Any candidate producing any other medical board disability certificate will not be entitled for seat under PwD class.
- If any Candidate fails in scrutiny or unable to produce the required documents at the time of scrutiny/ admission (within stipulated time) in any round of counseling then the admission authorities have the right to cancel the Allotted seat, also the candidate will be ineligible for any further round of counseling.

e) **Completion of Admission Procedure:**

Candidates after successful scrutiny have to complete admission process along with payment of college fee.

ROUND-2

Eligibility –

- a) Candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Round-1.
- b) Who have filled choices for Round-2.

- c) Those submitted willingness for upgradation in Round -1 are eligible for Round-2.

Ineligibility: Candidates who had been allotted any seat in Round-1, but did not take admission will not be eligible for Round-2.

Process of Round-2

- a) Exercising fresh choices & Locking of Choices
- b) Seat Allotment
- c) Publication of result of Round-2.
- d) Document verification/Scrutiny
- e) Completion of Admission Procedure

Note: After admission, candidates can submit their willingness for Upgradation in MOP-Up round. If any candidate after seat allotment does not take admission or he gets admitted and withdraw/left the seat after that, then he will also be ineligible for further round of counseling.

MOP-UP ROUND

Eligibility:

- a) All registered candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Round-1/ Round-2.
- b) Who have filled choices for Mop-Up Round.
- c) The candidates who have submitted their willingness for upgradation in Round-1 or Round-2 or both are eligible for MOP-Up round.

Ineligibility: Candidates who had been allotted any seat in Round-1 or Round-2, but did not take admission.

Seats conversion:- Conversion of seats (if available) will be done in MOP-Up round as per admission rules. There will be no upgradation after Mop-Up round.

Process of Mop-Up round:

- a) Exercising fresh choices & Locking of Choices

- b) Seat Allotment
- c) Publication of result of MOP-Up Round
- d) Document verification/Scrutiny
- e) Completion of Admission Procedure:

Note: If candidate is allotted any Institute in MOP-Up round and he does not take admission or he gets admission & withdraw/left the seat after that, he will not be eligible for further counseling.

STRAY VACANCY ROUND

- Seats remaining vacant (not joined/withdrawn) after Mop-Up round will be filled through Stray Vacancy Round.
- A fresh registration will be done for Stray Vacancy Round. Candidates of Chhattisgarh State and other States are eligible for registration.

Eligibility:

- a) Pre-Registered candidates who have not been allotted any seat up to MOP up round.
- b) Fresh registered candidates in stray vacancy round.

Ineligibility: Candidates who have been allotted any seat in any round (up to Mop Up round) will be ineligible for Stray Vacancy round. Candidate joined/holding a seat in AIQ by AACCC.

- a) Exercising fresh choices & Locking of Choices
- b) Seat Allotment
- c) Publication of result of Stray Vacancy Round
- d) Document verification/Scrutiny
- e) Physical Reporting & Completion of Admission Procedure:
