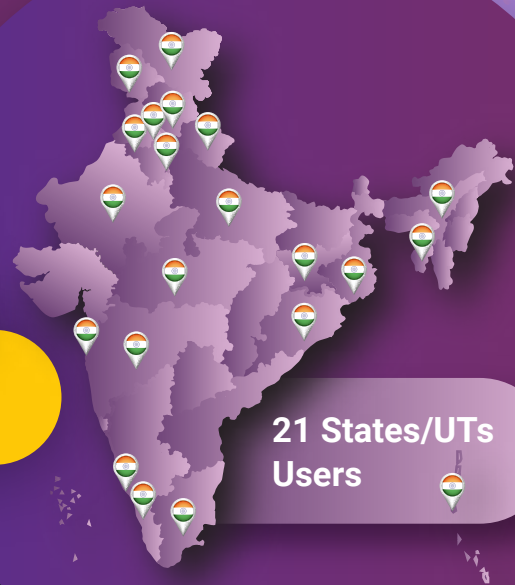

Auction is the process of Buying/Selling/Lease of goods or services by offering them for bidding and then selling to the highest bidder or buying the item from the lowest bidder. Auction is the second largest methodology adopted after tendering, amongst the various ways by which the government conducts its procurement activities.

National Informatics Centre, MeitY, GoI has developed a generic electronic auction (eAuction) platform to facilitate various kinds of online Auctions. It is offered in Platform As a Service model in <https://eauction.gov.in> and provides an immediate onboarding facility.

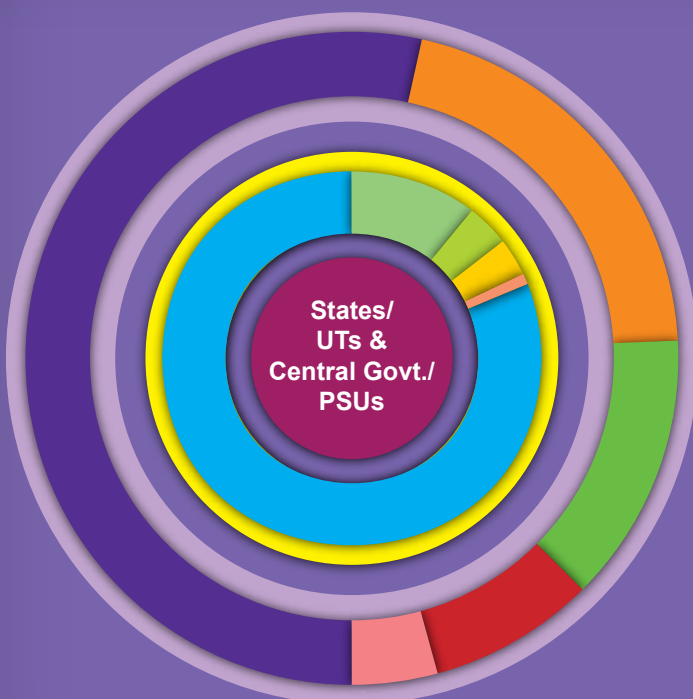

E-auction of tendu leaves boosts coffer
 The state government has so far collected Rs 51.19 crore during the first phase of the e-auction process for FY2019-20, almost triple the gross revenue collection through the manual system during FY2014-15. The department had collected Rs 18.12 crore in sale and purchase of tendu leaves through the manual system.
 "Apart from ensuring transparency between the department and applicants, the tender system has helped us generate good revenue. If things go on like this, the gross revenue collection of the department may quadruple in comparison to other years' gross collection", said managing director of the Jharkhand State Forest Development Corporation (JSFDC), N Singh.
 While the process for the second tender is on, the final tender of this fiscal will end by the first week of March. The department had to open 13 phased tenders to sell at 300 lots in 2015. This time around, three phased tenders will be enough, "said Singh.
 According to information from the fourth unit of JSFDC, the total revenue collection during the first phase touched Rs 1.22 crore, an upsurge from the gross revenue collection of around Rs 42 lakh during 2014-15.
 "We did not expect such a lucrative opportunity, since most areas of the region are dominated by forests. Their quality
