***Note 3: The property held by a 'Family' in different locations or different places/cities have been clubbed while applying the land or property holding test to determine EWS status.

Note: In CCET, there are two types of EWS categories:-

1. "General-EWS" (10% of the intake)-For EWS candidates not covered under SC, ST and BC categories. These candidates are required to upload INCOME & ASSETS CERTIFICATE.
2. "EWS under Tuition Fee Waiver Scheme" (5% of the intake)- Under this category, candidates are required to upload Affidavit and Family Income Certificate..
