The Web Portal and Mobile App has been designed and developed by the NIC Madhya Pradesh for the Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen), MP.

The system has been designed and developed as a suit of an online web-based portal and a mobile app which acts as an effective tool for automation, management and monitoring of various activities and processes involved in the implementation of Phase-II of SBM (G).

Key Features and Modules of the Web Portal and Mobile App have been explained through a presentation.

As part of phase – II of SBM (G), IEC activities have to be carried out to spread awareness on various aspects of ODF plus. SwachchaGrahis will be reporting the same using the Mobile App.

The Web Portal and Mobile App will facilitate a role based access to all individuals/ stakeholders for online submission of their activities using web and mobile interface. It will allow SwachhaGrahis to report their activities directly from the field using the Mobile App. It will also help in assessment of activities performed by SwachhaGrahis for the automated calculation of their incentives.
