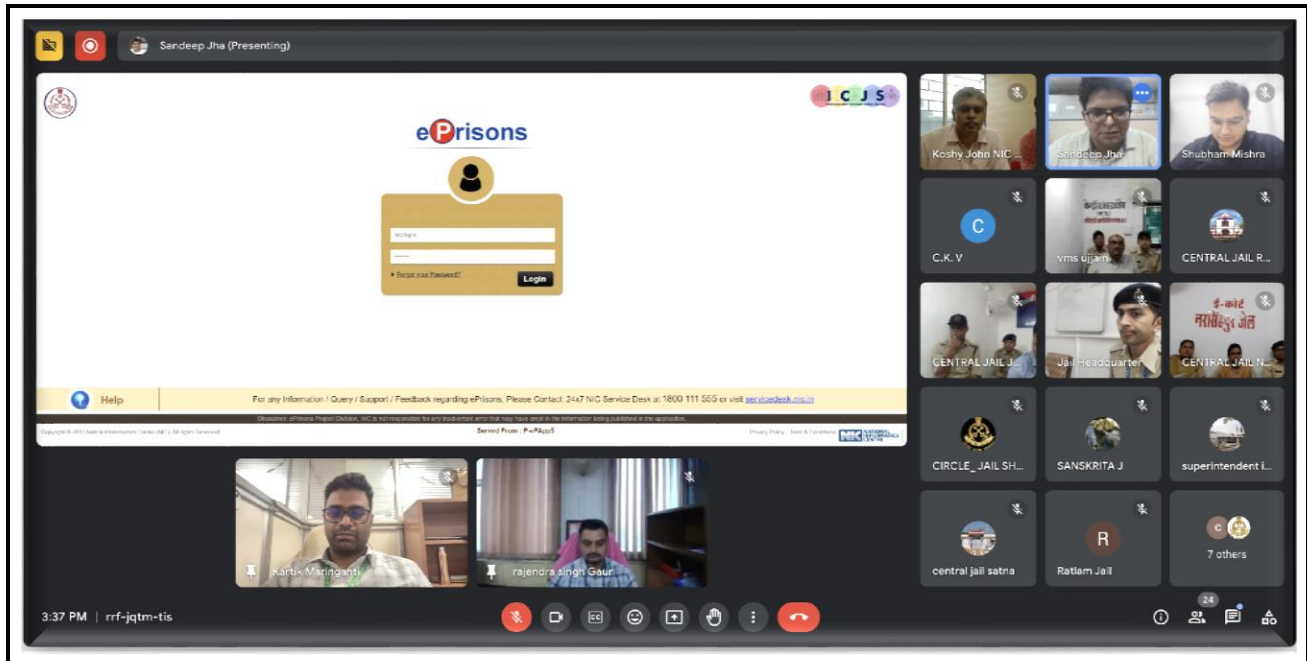


TRAINING SESSION ON EPRISONS ORGANIZED BY NIC FOR MADHYA PRADESH PRISONS

This platform also offers services to external agencies like Court, Police, and Citizens through its workflow-based solutions like National prisons portal, eMulakat, eParole, eCustody, NALSA, Bail order delivery system etc. ePrisons MIS is a comprehensive product covering working processes of various prisons across the country and it covers the entire lifecycle of the prisoner. It is an internationally acclaimed product implemented not only in all states of India but also internationally.

New services in ePrisons

- During training, hands-on sessions were conducted for the new services of ePrisons i.e.,
- 1) Inmate Lodging Management: It provides intelligent ward and barrack allocations and alerts prison authorities in advance in case of any conflicts or threats.
 - 2) Custody Certificate covers the workflow of requesting custody certificates from courts and preparation and submission of digitally signed certificates by the prisons.
 - 3) Parole Jumper and escapee information portal for citizens as per the supreme court direction.
 - 4) Premature Release system which covers the entire process from generation of request to approval by the government.
 - 5) Biometric based Prisoner Attendance.
 - 6) Police Intelligence System for providing alerts to police and police escort requests.
