Objective

e-Governance Applications often rollout a millions of messages via SMS for information dissemination, citizen/ business engagement, notification for the status of applications, etc. Often these messages contain URLs which allow the receiver to access the desired website for detailed information.

mini-U is a tool that transforms a URL into a short URL. This short URL is a more shareable URL that can direct to the web pages represented by your URL. Developed at NICMP, mini-U has been implemented successfully in some portals.

It supports shortening of urls of .gov.in and .nic.in domains.

How is it Useful

1. Cost Savings when sharing URLs via SMS

e-Governance Applications are billed by SMS service providers as a factor of the number of characters in the message. This implies the longer the URL in a message the higher cost of sending the SMS. Using the URL Shortening Service provided by mini-U the applications can achieve significant savings on the cost of SMS, containing URLs, incurred by them.

2. Less Dense and Dynamic QR Codes

QR, or Quick Response, codes deliver immense value as their ease of use and as they are a no-contact medium for exchanging information. With the ability to scan a code just by pointing your phone's camera at it, QR codes are a great addition to informational material, point of purchase (POP) material, business cards, and more.

A static QR code contains information that cannot be changed. Once the QR is created the destination URL cannot be altered. A dynamic QR code can be edited by the creator, even after they've been created. The dynamic QR code could be linked to a new destination URL.

Advantages

- A dynamic QR Code printed on a sign board could be linked to newer URLs as when the need arises.
- The more information embedded in a QR code, the more complex the code will be. That is a QR code with a long URL embedded in it will be very dense.
- Sparse QR Code does not require High Definition Printers when publishing pamphlets and banners.
- Banners and Pamphlets with Sparse QR Code offer good durability because even faded and crumpled Sparse QR Code could be read by a scanner.
