


Description of the Project

MMGSY has been started in order to provide road connectivity to habitations/ villages within the range of population between 500 and 999 which are not covered under the (PMGSY) till the year 2013. MPRRDA(M.P. Rural Road Development Authority) is appointed as a nodal agency for connecting habitations/ villages which does not cover under the PMGSY scheme. These habitations will also be connected through Road network under MMGSY scheme of State Government of MP.

GeoReach is an e-Governance solution being developed for monitoring the workflow of Rural road connectivity project. GIS part of application strengthen user to take better decision for creation of infrastructure. It also helps in maintaining inventory of rural roads. The application covers management, technical and financial aspects of the project. It aids and assists the MPRRDA officials, World Bank, Civil Contractors, Banks, SQM and general public. It is a G2B, G2G & G2C enterprise solution which has an access via internet <https://gismp.nic.in/georeach> available in public domain. It's a fusion of new & emerging technologies like Cryptography (Digital Signature & SSL), GIS & Remote Sensing, Mobile, Open Web technology, SMTP & SMS.

It provides interface for public to participate in the monitoring of road maintenance. Citizen can upload Geo-tagged photographs to raise their grievances on the condition of the road. The efforts have been made for integrating PFMS in GeoReach application.

Status of the Project

GeoReach is successfully running on the web and is extensively being used by MPRRDA. More than **Rs. 3252 Crore payment** has been disbursed to contractors directly to their bank account till end of February, 2026 through PFMS. Department has conducted **26.48 thousand inspections** which includes stage passing and pre-project works.

MPRDC has been notified as State Highway Authority as per Section 4 of the MP State Highway Act 2004 by the

Status of the Project

Project is implemented and necessary support is provided to MPRDC.

State Government. Section 5 of the Act 2004 authorizes MPRDC for the restriction or regulation of use of land appurtenant to Highways and Section 12 of the Act 2004 notification for Building lines and control lines. Any infrastructure that comes up or certain activities on MPRDC roads requires due permission from MPRDC. Site where the permission is sought is inspected by MPRDC field officers. Permission is sought for Retail outlets (Petrol Pumps, Restaurants etc.), cable laying/ pipeline, Overbridge, Oversized vehicle etc. Access Permission Management System (APMS) is an online application used for automation of process for restriction/ regulation of use of land appurtenant by the beneficiaries/ owner. APMS handles the work flow, online submission/ track and makes process transparent. Department scrutinize the online application received for access permission and gives NOC to applicant.

APMS is successfully running on the web and is extensively being used by MPRDC. More than **Rs. 40.41 Crore payment** has been received from till end of February, 2026 through online payment gateway PayGov. Department has received **3603** applications for access permissions.

4. MPeDistrict – Citizen Service Delivery Portal

Description of the Project :

To improve Citizen Service Delivery, eDistrict project MMP was conceptualized by Meity, MCIT GOI under the NeGP, which was being implemented by State Government in MP as **MPeDistrict portal in September 2012.**

Immigration, Visa, Foreigner’s Registration and Tracking (IVFRT) is one of the central a Mission Mode Projects (MMP) in the National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) which is conceptualized with an aim to enhance the experience of in-bound and out-bound travellers from and to India by looking into the aspects of Passport, Visa, Immigration, Foreigners’ Registration and Tracking with a vision ‘to develop a secure and integrated service delivery framework that facilitates legitimate travellers while strengthening security.’

There are application modules which are designed to provide secured ICT based solution for various stakeholders at the district as well as the state level. The various application modules of IVFRT being implemented in Madhya Pradesh are as follows:

- **S-FORM Module** : Student Form module is for online filing of S-Forms of foreigner foreigner students studying in educational institutes.
- **PRC Module** : This module helps to clear Prior Reference Check applications received from the missions within the stipulated time frame of 21 days.
- **DPM Module** : This module equips the State Police up to the district level with authentic foreigners information in their jurisdiction. It also enables the tracking of illegal immigrants across the country.
- **Immigration Control System (ICS)** : The ICS module is for computerizing the Immigration services at the Immigration Check Posts.
