Regarding appointment of Section Officer SAS (part-1) purely on 'Stop Gap Arrangement'.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

- 2. In view of the repeated demand from various Government Offices/ Boards and Corporations regarding appointment of Section Officers in their establishments, the entire matter has been examined. Accordingly, it has been decided to seek option for appointment of Section Officer SAS (Part-I) purely as a stop Gap Arrangement from those candidates who have qualified SAS (Part-I) examination.
- 3. All the eligible candidates can give their option by 27.04.2015. The willing candidates shall be appointed as Section Officer as a 'Stop Gap Arrangement' in their own pay scale with a Special Pay of Rs. 100/- subject to the following conditions:-
 - ١. That this shall be a purely 'Stop Gap Arrangement' and official offered appointment to the said post shall have no right to the post of SAS Section Officer until and unless he has qualified the Part II of SAS exam.
 - 11. On the appointment of permanent Section Officers these candidates shall be reverted back to their parent department.
 - III. Since this is a purely 'Stop Gap Arrangement' and in their own pay scale with a of Rs. 100/- Special Pay, no candidates can claim the regular pay scale or any other benefit attached to the post. The candidates will become the member of SAS cadre only after qualifying the SAS Part II exam and the seniority shall be fixed thereafter in the cadre.
 - IV. In case of disciplinary action these candidates shall be strictly governed by their parent department. However, the Director of Treasuries & Accounts Department will have the right of recommendation for initiating disciplinary

proceedings

- V. These Officials shall be required to pass the SAS Part-II in the next exam, failing which they shall be reverted back to their parent department. This condition would be applicable to the previous such Section Officers who are working as Section Officers passing Part-I examination as as 'Stop Gap Arrangement'.
- VI. Further, this 'Stop Gap Arrangement' will also subject to the final outcome of CWP No. 26672 of 2014 i.e. Sanjay Kumar v/s State of Haryana which is pending for adjudication before the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court.
