Appointment of Court employees as Section Officer who have qualified
SAS Part-II Examination-2019.

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

It is submitted that as per Chief Secretary, Haryana letter no 45/10/1999-5GSI dated 19.02.2015, wherein Court employees were not eligible to appear in the SAS examination. However, some Court employees who have already qualified SAS Part-I examination prior to issuances of these instructions were allowed to appear in SAS Part II exam in August, 2019 provisionally subject to the final advice of Chief Secretary, Haryana. Also, some other court employees were allowed to take the SAS Part-I examination as per court orders. In this regard, It is informed that the advice of CS office is still awaited.

In view of this, it has been decided that being appointing authority of the Ministerial staff of Court, the name of 21 candidates of the court who have qualified SAS Part II examination 2019 (Copy enclosed) are referred to your office for appointment of these 21 candidates as Section Officer against the post of Section Officer in various Session Courts in the State sanctioned by Finance Department vide letter No 1/29/2018-2FGI/27465 dated 25.10.2018 (copy attached).

As these candidates are borne on the establishment of the Court, they will continue to be employee of Court and not as a part of SAS cadre of the State Government. Hon'ble High Court of Punjab & Haryana in CWP No. 15953 of 2012 has passed the order on the same lines stating that candidates of Court allowed to appear in SAS Part-I & II exam will not lay any claim to SAS cadre in the State of Haryana on the basis of their participation and successfully negotiating such examination.

Subject: - Regarding the employees who have been appointed by way of transfer from Haryana Vidhan Sabha in Government Department under the State.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to invite your attention to the Government instruction bearing No. 45/10/99- 5GSI, dated 12th March, 2009, wherein it has been stated that employees working in Haryana Vidhan Sabha Secretariat are neither employees of any Department of Government of Haryana nor State Government employees and as such they cannot be appointed on transfer basis in the other Department of the State of Haryana. As far as the employees who are appointed on transfer basis in different Departments of State of Haryana prior to the Judgement dated 26.05.1999 in CWP No. 13701 of 1998 titled as Dalbir Singh Vs State of Haryana & others is concerned, their cases may be dealt with individually. Who have been promoted subsequently on higher post on the basis of some examination or on the basis of some interview they may not be repatriated. However, in case of others whose lien is still there in their parent department i.e. Haryana Vidhan Sabha and the department who have given in writing in pursuance to the communication dated 04.05.1999 that they will be abide by the decision of the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 13701 of 1998, these employees can be repatriated to their parent department since they were retained in these departments subject to decision of the CWP No. 13701 of 1998.

2. The matter has been further considered by the Government and it has been decided that the employees of Haryana Vidhan Sabha/ High Court / Distt. Court, who have already been transferred to other various departments

may not be repatriated to their parent unit. However from now onwards no employees from of Haryana Vidhan Sabha / High Court/ Distt. Court should be taken/ appointed on transfer basis in departments of the State Government
