Subject:- New Death Withdrawal Functionality.

Please refer to the subject cited above.


In this regard it is intimate to you that the existing online death withdrawal functionality and Death Withdrawal Form has been modified by CRA-NSDL, Mumbai. The revised Death Withdrawal Form and new online death withdrawal functionality will be implemented in the CRA system w.e.f. April 17, 2021. As per new withdrawal functionality, the Nodal Office will be required to initiate only single request for lump-sum (maximum of 20 % share) as well as annuity share (minimum of 80 % share) and authorise the same. Also, the death withdrawal request will be obtained from the Claimant/family members of the deceased Subscriber as per new Death Withdrawal Form. The new Death Withdrawal Form is enclosed for your reference.

In view of the same, the following is to be noted that:-

1. Revised Death Withdrawal Form and new online death withdrawal functionality will be released for use from April 17, 2021 in the CRA system.
2. From April 17, 2021 all death withdrawal requests need to be initiated in new functionality.
3. All death withdrawal requests (either lump sum or annuity requests) which are pending for authorization (either authorize or reject) need to be processed by April 16, 2021 by the Nodal Offices.
4. On end of the day (EOD) of April 16, 2021, all pending death online withdrawal requests (pending for authorization) will be cancelled in CRA system.
 - (i) Nodal office will have to re-initiate such requests in CRA system as per new functionality.
 - (ii) If request for annuity share is cancelled, then Nodal Office will have to initiate & authorize request for annuity share in new functionality.
 - (iii) If request for lump-sum share is cancelled, then Nodal Office will have to initiate a new combined request for lump-sum share as well as annuity share in new functionality.
5. Nodal Offices/DTOs can accept physical forms in old format till April 10, 2021. However, the requests needs to be initiated by April 13, 2021. Online Death withdrawal initiation would be temporarily disabled from April 13, 2021 to April 16, 2021 for system upgradation to release revised death withdrawal form.
6. Physical withdrawal request which were received by Nodal Offices and not initiated till April 13, 2021, will have to be processed in new death withdrawal functionality.

You are, therefore, requested to initiate all pending death case requests till April 13, 2021 and complete the authorization of all pending requests by April 16, 2021 to avoid re-initiation of the withdrawal requests.


