This has reference to the letter of the Dean ESIC-MC &PGIMSR, Rajajinagar, Bengaluru, vide letter cited in the above reference. In this connection, though constitutional amendment has been made providing reservation to an extent of 10% to the Economically weaker section of the forward communities, the State Government is yet to issue appropriate roaster points for inclusion of the same in the seat matrix.

Under the above circumstances, such of the eligible candidates falling under Economically weaker section of the forward communities (whose castes do not fall under any of the categaries) are required to seek the reservation by making option entries in respect of Government of India pooled seats. As regards reservation in respect of available seats in the State Quota, they are invariably required to wait for the issual of appropriate orders by the Government, in the backward classes department.
