

ADMISSION NOTICE: SUPERSPECIALITY COURSES AT AFMS INSTITUTIONS THROUGH COMMON COUNSELING BY DGHS, MoHFW FOR THE YEAR 2021 (TO BE HELD IN APR 2022)

1. Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) conducts Post-doctoral/Superspeciality training at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune and Army Hospital (R&R), Delhi primarily to cater for the requirement of doctors in the Armed Forces. Subsequent to the introduction of Common Counseling as per direction of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India all DM/MCh seats at AFMC Pune and DNB-SS seats at AH (R&R), Delhi Cantt are a part of the common counseling at national level under Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), DGHS, MoHFW and all candidates are eligible for the same. The seat allotment will be as per merit cum choice.

2. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA.** The eligibility criteria for admission to Super Speciality courses in AFMS institutions are categorized as follows:-

(a) **Categories**

(i) **Serving officers of the AFMS:** AFMS officers who have been granted study leave.

(ii) **Medical Officers sponsored by Para Military Forces/other Govt. of India organizations:** A Sponsorship Certificate as per Appx 'A' issued by the sponsoring authority to the candidate, specific to the subject allotted, is a mandatory requirement for admission.

(iii) **Ex-SSC AFMS officers:**

(aa) Officers released from service after completion of contractual service, within three years after the release from service are eligible for admission with no service/bond liability. The date of release should not be before 01 Nov 2018 for the 2021 session starting tentatively from April 2022.

(ab) Officers who have resigned the commission/dismissed/removed from service/ not completed the contractual service are **NOT ELIGIBLE** under this category.

(ac) AFMS officers with date of release from service prior to 01 Nov 2018 will have service/bond liability as applicable to civilian doctors.

(iv) **Civilian doctors:**

(aa) Maximum permissible age shall be less than 32 years as on 31 Dec 2022 (i.e. date of birth is on or after 01 Jan 1991) to fulfill the service liability as mentioned here under.

(ab) A doctor who fails to complete the course successfully for any reason before crossing 35 years of age as on 31 Dec 2025 (considering the course starts in 2022-2025) **WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE** for commission in the Armed Forces and would have to pay the cost of training of the course.

(ac) The candidate should be willing to serve the Armed Forces Medical Services (AFMS) for 05 years subject to fulfilling other eligibility criteria. **Candidate will have to execute a bond agreement as per Appx 'B' at the time of admission, to pay a sum of Rs. Fifty Four Lacs (Rs. 54,00,000/-) to Govt. of India**, in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered commission on completion of the course.

(ad) Civilian doctors will have to undergo medical examination by duly constituted medical board at the time of admission, so as to assess their fitness for commissioning as per laid down criteria and will be admitted only if found **MEDICALLY FIT**.

(b) **Qualifications:** Candidate must have MBBS & MD/MS/DNB Degrees registered with State Medical Council or MCI/NMC. Students who have completed Post-Graduation by 31 December 2021 are eligible for admission.

(c) **The candidate must be a citizen of India.**

(d) A candidate who is already pursuing any superspeciality course shall not be eligible for admission to another Super Speciality course in the Academic Year 2021-22.

4. **COUNSELING.** The common counseling for all seats of NEET-SS at National level will be conducted by Directorate General of Health Services (DGHS), MoHFW. Hence, all eligible candidates desirous of admission to superspeciality courses {DM/MCh/DNB(SS)} in AFMS institutions for the 2021 session commencing tentatively from Apr 2022 will have to register on the portal for Superspeciality counselling on the MCC website: www.mcc.nic.in.

5. **PROCESS OF ADMISSION AND MEDICAL EXAMINATION.**

(a) Following procedure will be carried out at the respective AFMS institution in the sequence mentioned below for the candidates allotted DM/MCh/DNB (SS) seats during Super Speciality Counselling-2021(session commencing tentatively from Apr 2022) by MCC

Document Verification by Board of Officers on the day of reporting



Medical Examination of the candidates by a separate Board of Officers over 2-3 days



Declaration of medical Examination results by Presiding Officers of Medical Examination



Candidates found **MEDICALLY FIT** will submit the Surety Bond agreement and deposit his / her original documents

(Note : The candidates should arrange for their boarding and lodging for approximately 04-05 days. Candidates are advised to report to allotted institute at the earliest after declaration of the result of online counseling as specified)

(b) In view of the COVID-19 pandemic, candidates will be required to take all due precautions in terms of wearing a mask, practicing social distancing throughout the medical examination process and carrying personal sanitizer at all times etc. Please note that the candidate **SHALL NOT** be accompanied by any other person and **ONLY THE CANDIDATE SHALL BE ALLOWED INSIDE THE COLLEGE PREMISES** to avoid unnecessary gathering.

- (c) Candidates while reporting for admission will have to bring the following documents :-

 - (v) Copy of University Mark Sheet of first to final MBBS examinations and Post-Graduation course.
 - (vi) Copy of Internship Completion Certificate.
 - (vii) Copy of Permanent/Provisional state Medical Council Registration Certificate of MBBS & Post graduation course
 - (viii) Copy of MBBS & Post-Graduation degrees (Passing Certificate if degree has not been received.)
 - (ix) Copy of Nationality Certificate/Xerox copy of valid Passport/Domicile Certificate/Birth Certificate.
 - (x) Copy of Attempt Certificate (MBBS & MD/MS/DNB as applicable).
 - (xi) Copy of Transfer Certificate for non-AFMC candidates.
 - (xii) Copy of Migration certificate for non-MUHS candidates.
 - (xiii) Copy of Adhar Card.
 - (xiv) Sponsorship Certificate in case of Medical Officers sponsored by Para-Military Forces/Govt. of India organization. Sponsorship Certificate issued by the sponsoring authority should be specific to the subject allotted and is a mandatory requirement for the candidate to be considered for admission as a sponsored candidate.
 - (xv) In case of Ex-AFMS/SSC Officers, release order from Armed Forces Medical Services issued by DGAFMS/concerned Medical Directorate.
 - (xvi) Civilian candidates, if selected, will be required to execute a bond agreement at the time of admission, to pay a sum of **Rs. Fifty Four Lacs Only (Rs. 54,00,000/-)** to Govt. of India, in case unwilling to join AFMS when offered commission on completion of the course as per **GoI letter No: 17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D/334/21/D(Med) dated 15 March 2021.**

Note: Admission to DM/MCh and DNB (SS) courses at AFMS institutions is provisional subject to confirmation/ ratification by the O/o DGAFMS, MUHS Nashik, NMC & NBE. Candidates are free to seek any clarification before accepting a seat during counseling.

2. And whereas the **post-doctoral** Students has undertaken to join and continue Post-doctoral studies in accordance with rules and regulations of the _____ (Institute Name & University Name) for obtaining **DM/MCh & DNB (SS)** in _____ (Subject) of the _____ (Name of University) and join the Armed Forces Medical Services as a short service commissioned Officer on successful completion of the course if found medically fit for the same. And whereas in consideration of the government having agreed to sanction the admission to the said post-doctoral student, the candidate along with the surety has agreed to execute the above bond with such conditions as hereunder written.

(a) That in consideration of the Post-doctoral students being admitted by the Govt. to _____ (Institute Name) for the purpose of obtaining **post-doctoral** degree the post-doctoral student and surety covenant with the Government that the said Post-doctoral student will attend the _____ (Institute Name) for obtaining post-doctoral degree and such other training as Government may determine from time-to-time for the prescribed period until he/she successfully completes his/her post-doctoral degree course and is declared fit (as to which the decision of Director General Armed Forces Medical Services shall be final) to be granted Short Services Commission and that the Post-doctoral student will be commissioned as a Medical Officer in the regular Indian Army or the Indian Navy or India Air Forces as SSC Officers to serve for 5 years unless he/she, the post-doctoral student is prevented from doing so on account of ill health or some other reason over which he/she, the post-doctoral student has no control as determined by a service medical board (as to which the Government shall be the sole judge) or by being removed on the ground that the student is considered by the appropriate authority to the unfit to continue as post-doctoral student, or any other ground, to be granted a commission.

(b) That in the event the Post-doctoral student either attains the age of 35 years as on 31 December of the year of successful completion of his/her Post-doctoral course or refuses to accept commission in the Armed Forces Medical Services on successful completion of his/her Post-doctoral course the Post-doctoral student and the Surety shall jointly be liable to pay and refund forthwith to the Government of India on demand and without demur an amount of **Rs 54 Lakhs (Rupees Fifty Four Lakhs only) as per Govt of India letter No 17436/DGAFMS/DG-1D dated 15 Mar 2021 and No. 3569/DGAFMS/DG-1B(i)/389/21/D (Med) dt 19 Apr 2021 together with interest on the said money, calculated at the rates in force then.** The interest will be calculated after 30 days from date of successful completion of Post-doctoral course or from the designated date of joining the Armed Forces unit as per the posting order issued.

(c) That the post-doctoral student shall on successful completion of his/her post-doctoral degree course will report within such period, as may be allowed by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services as joining time to the unit or station as specified in this behalf by the Director General Armed Forces Medical Services for grant of Short Service Commission on terms and conditions set out in Army Instruction 75/78 and amended time-to-time.

(d) That if the post-doctoral student after grant of short service commission applies for release from service within **Five years** of grant said commission for any reason whatsoever and provided his/ her release is sanctioned by the Govt of India, as per rules in force, he/ she shall be relieved only after he/ she has refunded bond money at the rate of **Rupees Ten Lakhs Eighty Thousands** per completed year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability limited to the bond money as contained in the bond agreement executed at the of admission.

(e) That if the post-doctoral student leaves the institution without completing the course due to any reason after the last date of admission to the post-doctoral course as specified by MCI/affiliated University, he/ she will be required to pay a sum of **Rupees Eighteen Lakhs** per year or part thereof of the education at the institution based on extant rules.

(f) That the post-doctoral student made **Non Service Liability (NSL)** on medical grounds will be required to pay bond money at 50% of amount laid down , before he/ she is allowed to continue his/her studies. However, in case of student becoming medically unfit for commission due to any disease or disability contracted in the circumstances over which he/ she has no control (on which the decision of the DGAFMS shall be final) and for which he/ she has not refused treatment, he/ she will not be required to pay any Bond money but will have to pay the cost of training as applicable for further period of study from the date declared NSL.

(g) That if the **Post-doctoral DM/MCh/DNB (SS)** student leaves the institution and refuses to fulfill any of the bond conditions, his/her original documents will not be handed over until he/she pays the surety bond money as applicable and any other dues decided by the Commandant of the AFMS institution.

(h) That if the **Post-Doctoral DM/MCh/DNB(SS)** Student leaves the training institute voluntarily without completing the course due to any reason (other than medical grounds) after the permissible withdrawal period as governed by the prospectus, if any, will be liable to pay the amount of the Bond Money at rate proportionate to the amount of the Bond Money at a rate proportionate to the amount of time trained in the institute, limited to the total Bond Money as contained the Bond Money executed now.

(j) That if the **Post-Doctoral DM/MCh/DNB(SS)** student rendered as Non Service Liability (NSL) due to reasons other than medical grounds (viz. indiscipline, failure to adhere to the stipulated code of conduct, violation of medical ethics etc.) will be removed from the College Rolls and will be liable to pay the Bond Money as applicable to student and will not be allowed to continue further studies.

(k) That if the **Post-Doctoral DM/MCh/DNB(SS)** Student found to be medically unfit in the pre-commission medical exam due to pregnancy, will be reviewed by a medical board within six months of delivery and if found fit, will be offered SSC. The candidate will report to her parent teaching institution for such medical examination within six months of delivery. If the candidate fails to report to her parent teaching institution for the medical examination within the stipulated time or fails to join on being declared fit and offered SSC, she will be liable to pay the full Bond Money. If after review, she is found medically unfit for commission, she will be treated as NSL case and would be liable to pay Bond Money as contained in the Bond executed at the time of admission.

(l) That if the **Post-Doctoral DM/MCh/DNB(SS)** Student who on completion of the course wants to be released from service liability before completion of the Liability period, provided the same is accepted by the Government, will be liable to pay the amount of the Bond Money at a rate proportionate to each complete year or part thereof of unfulfilled liability, limited to the total Bond Money as contained in the Bond or the total amount as contained in the undertaking executed at the time of admission.

3. The Terms and conditions mentioned in the agreement may get revised/amended as per the directions of Govt of India as far as related to payment of bond money in default of honoring this agreement. The SURETY will be liable to agree to the same. In case of dispute, the decision of Govt of India will be final and binding on the Sureties or either.

4. In the event of noncompliance of the aforesaid clauses or failure on the part of Sureties to comply with the bond, the sum due hereunder will be liable to be recovered as an arrear of Land Revenue.

5. Under no circumstances does the clauses mentioned under section 133 & 135 of the Indian Contract Act, 1872 or any other rule of law or equity as applicable on that behalf, any indulgence of forbearances shown by the Govt of India to the candidates whether with or without consent of the sureties or either shall not operate as discharge of the sureties obligations under the said bond.

6. NOW THE CONDITION OF THE OBLIGATION is such that the post-doctoral student after grant of **Short Service Commission** serves for a period of **five years** or cause to be paid to the Government the amount due to his/ her in contravention of the bond agreement then this bond shall be void, otherwise the same shall be and remain in full force.
