Candidates participating in SS Couselling 2022 are informed as under:

As per the decision of MoHFW there will be a reduction in percentile for Super specialty counselling for the academic year 2022 and all candidates above 20th percentile will be eligible for SS counseling (for D.M/ M.Ch/ DNB SS Courses) in compliance with the directions of competent authority.

Hence, a **special Mop Up Round** will be conducted by Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of DGHS in compliance to the directions of MoHFW as per schedule uploaded on MCC website.

The rule position for Special Mop Up Round of SS Counselling 2022 is as under:

- Candidates who are not holding any seat in previous rounds (i.e Round 1 & Round 2) are eligible to participate in Special Mop Up Round.
- ➤ Candidates who will be allotted seats in Special Mop Up Round will have to report at the allotted Institute and join the seat with their original documents.
- ➤ The Security Deposit of candidates who do not join their allotted seats will be forfeited as per the counselling policy.

The Eligibility of candidates to participate in Mop Up Round of SS Counselling 2022 is reiterated as under:

• ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE:

- ✓ Candidates not holding any seat in the previous rounds of NEET-SS Counselling, 2022.
- ✓ Candidates who did not join their allotted seats in previous rounds and exited with forfeiture can participate in counselling after using 'RESET Registration' option and paying the requisite Fee.

• INELIGIBLE CANDIDATE:

A candidate already allotted & joined a seat in previous rounds.
