### **Kind Attention:**

### **Candidates participating in SS Counselling 2022 are informed as under:**

As per the decision of MoHFW there will be a reduction in percentile for Super specialty counselling for the academic year 2022 and all candidates above 20<sup>th</sup> percentile will be eligible for SS counseling (for D.M/ M.Ch/ DNB SS Courses) in compliance with the directions of competent authority.

Hence, a **special Mop Up Round** will be conducted by Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) of DGHS in compliance to the directions of MoHFW as per schedule uploaded on MCC website.

### **The rule position for Special Mop Up Round of SS Counselling 2022 is as under:**

- Candidates who are not holding any seat in previous rounds (i.e Round 1 & Round 2) are eligible to participate in Special Mop Up Round.
- Candidates who will be allotted seats in Special Mop Up Round will have to report at the allotted Institute and join the seat with their original documents.
- The Security Deposit of candidates who do not join their allotted seats will be forfeited as per the counselling policy.

**The Eligibility of candidates to participate in Mop Up Round of SS Counselling 2022 is reiterated as under:**

• **ELIGIBLE CANDIDATE:**

- ✓ Candidates not holding any seat in the previous rounds of NEET-SS Counselling, 2022.
- ✓ Candidates who did not join their allotted seats in previous rounds and exited with forfeiture can participate in counselling after using **‘RESET Registration’ option and paying the requisite Fee.**

• **INELIGIBLE CANDIDATE:**

A candidate already allotted & joined a seat in previous rounds.
