1. Purpose of this Document

This User Guide provides step-by-step instructions for candidates participating in NEET-UG Counselling 2026. It explains all candidate activities, including registration, filling of the application form, qualification details, selection of counselling, contact details, document upload (Indian and NRI), preview and final submission, fee payment, choice filling, choice locking, viewing seat allotment result, willingness submission, download of the provisional allotment letter, system generated letters, discrepancy removal and withdrawal from counselling.

Step-by-step Instructions

This section provides detailed, step-by-step instructions for performing various activities in the NEET UG Counselling 2026 Candidate Module. Candidates are advised to follow the instructions carefully and complete each activity within the timelines notified by the Counselling Authority:

2. Candidate Registration

Candidate Registration is a one-time process that enables eligible candidates to create their account and participate in the counselling process. During registration, candidates must provide the required credentials, verify their identity, create login credentials, and submit the registration form after accepting the applicable declarations and consent.

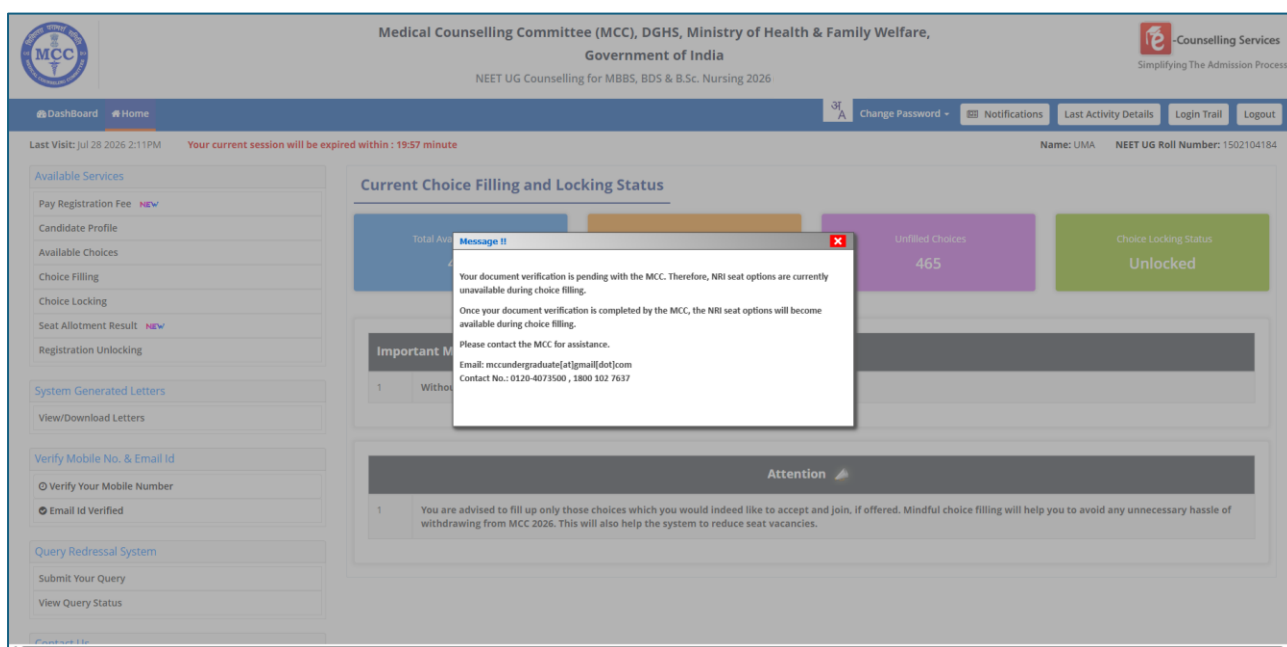
