CORRIGENDUM

Subject	Corrigendum to the Comprehensive Compliance Order under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 issued for the edible oil and fats sector in the State of Maharashtra vide No. COMM/COMPORDER/EDIBLE-OIL/1164/2026/07 dated 20th August 2026 (File No. FDA-14011(28)/2/2026-D6F50).
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WHEREAS this Administration has issued a Comprehensive Compliance and Enforcement Order for the edible oil and fats sector vide the number and date cited in the Subject above;

AND WHEREAS the requirement of the AGMARK Certification Mark appearing in clauses (11) and (13) of sub-regulation 2.3.14, and sub-regulation 2.3.8 together with FORM A, of the Food Safety and Standards (Prohibition and Restrictions on Sales) Regulations, 2011 stand omitted by the amendment notified vide REG-11027/2/2022-Regulation-FSSAI dated 17th October 2024, with the result that AGMARK certification is no longer mandatory;

AND WHEREAS the expression "Blended Edible Vegetable Oil" stands substituted by "Multi-Source Edible Oil" vide notification F. No. REG/Representation-MSEO/FSSAI-2021 dated 5th September 2022, and the said expression is the correct nomenclature under clause 24 of sub-regulation 2.2.1 of the Food Safety and Standards (Food Products Standards and Food Additives) Regulations, 2011;

AND WHEREAS the provisions of the said Order relating to nutritional and health claims require to be brought into conformity with regulation 8 and Schedules II A and V of the Food Safety and Standards (Advertising and Claims) Regulations, 2018;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers enabling me in this behalf, the following corrections are hereby made in the said Order:

1	Preamble (WHEREAS, item 6); Clause 3.6(b); Clause 4A(b); Clause 7(c); Clause 8.2.2; Clause 8.5.1; Clause 8.6.1; Clause 8.7.1; Clause 9.2(g); Clause 10(c)	Every reference requiring AGMARK certification for Multi Source Edible Vegetable Oil, and every reference to sale "without AGMARK" as a contravention.	The requirement of AGMARK certification stands deleted wherever it occurs. The remaining requirements of those clauses – namely the prohibition on sale in loose form, the sealed and tamper-proof pack not exceeding 15 kg, and the prescribed label declarations – continue to operate unaffected.
2	Throughout the Order, including the heading of Clause 4A	"Multi Source Edible Vegetable Oil (MSEVO)", and the expression "Multi Source Edible Oil" where it occurs in Clauses 3.6(b) and 3.6(c)	"Multi-Source Edible Oil (MSEO)", uniformly throughout the Order
3	Clause 3.6(c)	the words "heart-healthy" appearing in the illustrative list of impermissible claims	the following shall be read in its place: no food shall be described as "Healthy", in terms of sub-regulation (3) of regulation 8 of the Food Safety and Standards (Advertising and Claims) Regulations, 2018.
4	Clause 3.6(c)	the words "100% pure" appearing in the illustrative list of impermissible claims	the following shall be read in its place: the expression "Pure" may be used only to describe a single-ingredient food to which nothing has been added and which is free from avoidable contamination, in terms of Schedule V of the said Regulations; accordingly it shall not be used for a composite food or for Multi-Source Edible Oil, and its use for 100% pure mustard oil under Clauses 4A and 5 of the Order is not affected.
5	Clause 3.6(c)	the words prohibiting any nutrient-function or health claim specifically on Multi Source Edible Vegetable Oil	the following shall be read in its place: every nutritional and health claim in respect of edible oil, including Multi-Source Edible Oil, shall conform to the Food Safety and Standards (Advertising and Claims) Regulations, 2018 and to Schedule II A thereof.

All other provisions of the said Order shall remain unchanged and shall continue to operate.

This Corrigendum shall form an integral part of the said Order and shall be deemed to have taken effect from the date of issue of the said Order.
