The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting food grains for the months of April to June, 2011 will be up to 45 days and 50 days respectively from the date of issue of this letter and for the subsequent months of July to September 2011 will be as per instant instructions of the Government.

3. FCI will release the foodgrains (rice & wheat) as mentioned against each State/UT as in the above table. The said quantity of foodgrains will be released from the nearest godown / depot of FCI to States/UTs on prepayment of the cost of the foodgrains by the concerned State Government /UT Administration.

4. FCI may give suitable instructions to their concerned Regional Offices, accordingly under intimation to this Department.
