Subject :- Allocation of foodgrains (Rice and Wheat) under Welfare Institutions Scheme in the States namely Karnataka, Jammu & Kashmir, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra for the 1st half of the year 2014-15 i.e. from April 2014 to September 2014.

Sir,

In continuation of this Department's allocation orders of even number dated 13.5.2014, 21.5.2014 and 6.6.2014 on the above noted subject, I am directed to convey the approval of the Government of India for the monthly allocation of the following quantities of rice and wheat at BPL prices to the States of Karnataka, Jammu & Kashmir, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra under Welfare Institutions scheme for the first six months of the year 2014-15 i.e. from April to September 2014.

* The above allocation of foodgrains to State Government of Karnataka has been made after adjustment of balance quantity of 6524.42 tons of rice and 2797.37 tons of wheat.

2. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting food grains for the month of April & July 2014 will be up to 45 days and 50 days respectively from the date of issue of this letter and for the subsequent months i.e. August, 2014 and September 2014 will be as per instant instructions of the Government.

3. FCI will release the foodgrains (rice & wheat) to Government of Karnataka, Jammu & Kashmir, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra as indicated in the above para. The said quantity of foodgrains will be released from the nearest godown / depot of FCI to Karnataka, Jammu & Kashmir, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra on prepayment of the cost of the foodgrains at BPL rates by the concerned State Government.

4. FCI may give suitable instructions to their concerned Regional Offices, accordingly under intimation to this Department.
