Sir,

I am directed to refer to the issue raised by Govt. of Maharashtra in the meeting of Food Secretaries of States/UTs implementing NFSA, held on 03.12.2014 and the request of the State for revised allocation on account of coverage/actual average size of households under AAY category. The request of the State has been considered and it has been decided to revise the allocation of foodgrains to Maharashtra from January, 2015 onwards. Accordingly, in partial modification of this Department's allocation letter of even number dated 27.01.2014, the monthly allocation of foodgrains to Maharashtra from January, 2015 will be 383766 tons of foodgrains (188425 tons of rice and 215341 tons of wheat).

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2. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of foodgrains will be as per the revised instructions issued vide this Department's letter No.1-2/2007-BP.III dated 11.07.2014. Accordingly, the State Govt. is requested to ensure that the revised allocation of foodgrains for the month of January, 2015 is lifted by the end of December, 2014. Other terms and conditions mentioned in the allocation letter of even number dated 27.01.2014 remain unchanged.
